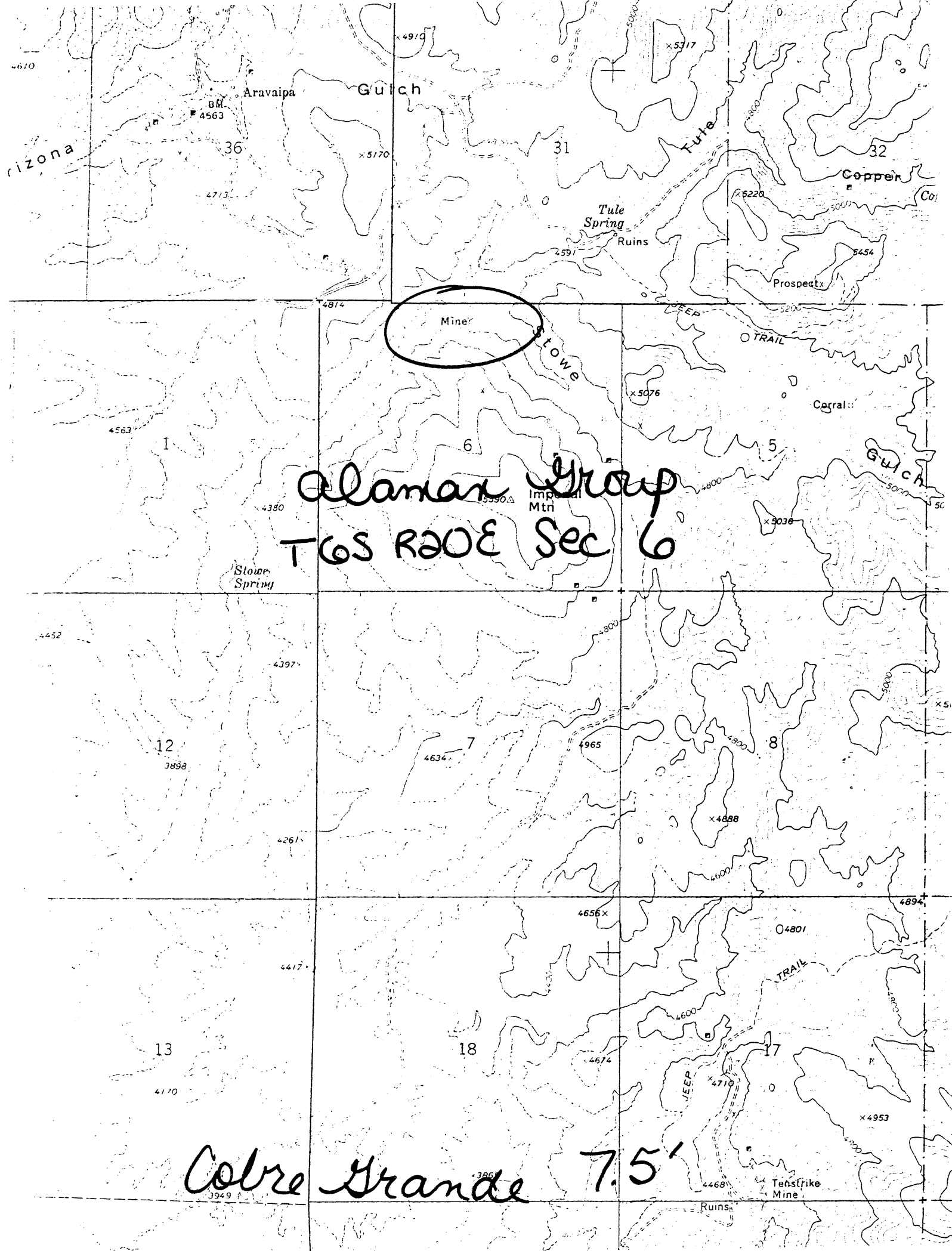

Dear Mr. Manning:

The determination of the sample (our No. 22605) you left at this office has been completed.

The white material is calcite. The greenish, radiating larger crystals are diopside (a variety of pyroxene). The metallic mineral in the form of needles and thin, narrow strips is either cosalite ($\text{PbS} \cdot \text{Bi}_2\text{S}_3$) or galenobismutite ($\text{PbS} \cdot \text{Bi}_2\text{S}_3$). The qualitative analysis indicated sulphur, lead and bismuth. Which one of these minerals it is cannot be told without a quantitative analysis.

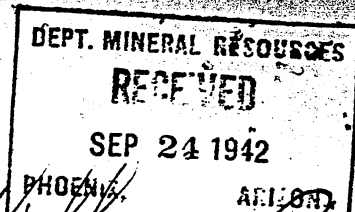
Both of these are new minerals to Arizona as far as we know, and we would appreciate it if you could obtain us some more, since there was very little of it on this specimen, and most of that was used up in the examination.

Number of Claims Formerly 13 claims, and now reported to be 23 claims. These claims are included in the 37 unpatented claims that are now leased by Williamson, Gullledge, Dempsey and Hatter from Frank & Landsman, as reported in a NEWS REPORT of the operations of Williamson, Gullledge, Dempsey, and Hatter in the Aravaipa District under date of April 10, 1952. No name has been given, as yet, to their mining company.

The above company is not now mining in this group of claims. Their operations are, at present, being conducted at the Ben Hur Group. A NEWS REPORT on their operations at the Ben Hur Group was also submitted under date of Dec. 12, 1951.

Operations in the Alaman Group is being considered by the leasers for the very near future.
