



Subject: News Report ---- Operations at Albatross Mine

✓ ALBATROSS MINE

The Albatross Mine, in the Arivaca Mining District, 5 miles north of Arivaca, owned by ✓ Stanley M. Secrist of Tucson, Arizona, was leased recently to Mr. ✓ C. L. Jarnegin of Arivaca. The lease was negotiated by ✓ John D. Mitchell of Arivaca, and is a 3 year lease, with option to purchase.

Mr. Jarnegin has completed repairs on his 25 ton mill located on Arivaca Creek 5 miles ^{north} west of Arivaca, and will haul the Albatross Mine ore to this mill for concentration, the distance from the mine to the mill being about 3 miles.

Mr. Jarnegin has also completed the necessary repairs on the road leading from the Albatross Mine to his mill, and reports that he is now ready to start mining the ore at the Albatross, and hauling same to his mill for concentration.

The ore at the Albatross is principally lead, with from \$10 to \$14 per ton of gold and silver values, and a small amount of copper.
