



Subject: Examination. L. Rahn Lessee.

PROPERTY LOCATION ; From the north-east end of the town of Ray an old wagon road leading up a rocky wash following this northeast direction for a total distance of about 1 1/4 miles, the old road terminated at the workings of the Calumet Mine, now of the Ray Consolidated Co. and at the main workings of the Bunker Hill mine, now named Apex No.2.

> The Apex No.2 is located further near the west side of Sec.12 T,3 S, and R,13 E, Pinal County, Arizona.

HISTORY OF MINE : It is well known locally and the evidences still remain at the surface of this mine; that a period of activity dating back towards the end of last century and during the first 18 or 20 years of this century, was expended in the exploration of this mine, and that a considerable tonnage of copper ore, has been produced and shipped to smelter.

> Under the name of the Bunker Hill, the property was at the active period, equipped with houses, hoist and air-compressor and an ore bin; these now are all removed or crumpled to ruins.

No work of any extent or rehabilitation has been attempted for the past several years and the road down the rocky canyon floor is now a complete ruin.

MINERAL OCCURRENCE; The copper ores are within the usual Schist of the Ray area, not far east of a contact between the schist and Dacite and andesite later intrusives.

Within the workings of the mine, there seems to be a main mineralization extending from the point marked Discovery shaft, thence north-westerly thru the old main shaft.

However the copper ores in spots now visible may not have a presistent downward continuation, but will no doubt have considerable lateral extention. There are evidences that the copper is within stratas which protrude to the surface in unconformable lenzes and bodies.

The Pinal schist being the host rock for the copper, this schist is favorable for copper deposition, as in the ajoining Calumet claim and the main workings of the Ray Herciles (formerly) and the contiguous claims of the Ray Consolidated Copper Co.

Examination of the dump material of the deep shaft did not find copper carbonate ores, the dump seems to be all a low sulfide of iron and copper and thin bands of quartz. All the upper copper exposures consists of the various form: of secondary copper.

About 15' below the caved collar of the old main shaft a body of good grade copper carbonate was cut thru on the sinking of the shaft, and along the north end it forms a face of ore in blanket shape No. 154 De


Mr. Louis Rahn is operating a copper mine at Ray and near Florence.

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




