Il miles west of Duncan on Highway # 70, then 2 miles north on private road.
Road reported to be in fair condition when dry. Slippery when wet.

Number of Claims 2 unpatented claims. (40 acres)

Owner L: G. Hales, Box 1145, Duncan, Ariz.

Operator Not in operation, at present.

Principal Minerals Red Sandstone. Resembles Coconino Sandstone. Building material.

Number of men employed None.

Rock in sight and probable Sandstone layer is 4 to 5 ft. deep, lying almost flat over an area of about 20 acres. Has a clay overburden about 1 ft. in thickness. Rock can be mined with a bulldozer.

Marketing Facilities Rock is sold for fences, walks, barbecues fireplaces to users in Willcox and Safford. Rock has been mined in large chunks, and sawed or split by purchasers according to their individual requirements.

Prices \$25 per ton delivered.

Mine Workings Surface workings about 150 ft. long, and 6 to 14 ft. wide.

Past History Mr. Hales was the original locator. Past production by Mr. Hales is very small. Mr. Hales reports selling one truckload in Phoenix, 2 truckloads in Tucson, 3 truckloads in Willcox, and 6 truckloads in Safford, and says he received \$25 per ton delivered.

Proposed Plans Mr. Hales wishes to lease or sell the property, as his health does not permit him to operate it himself.
