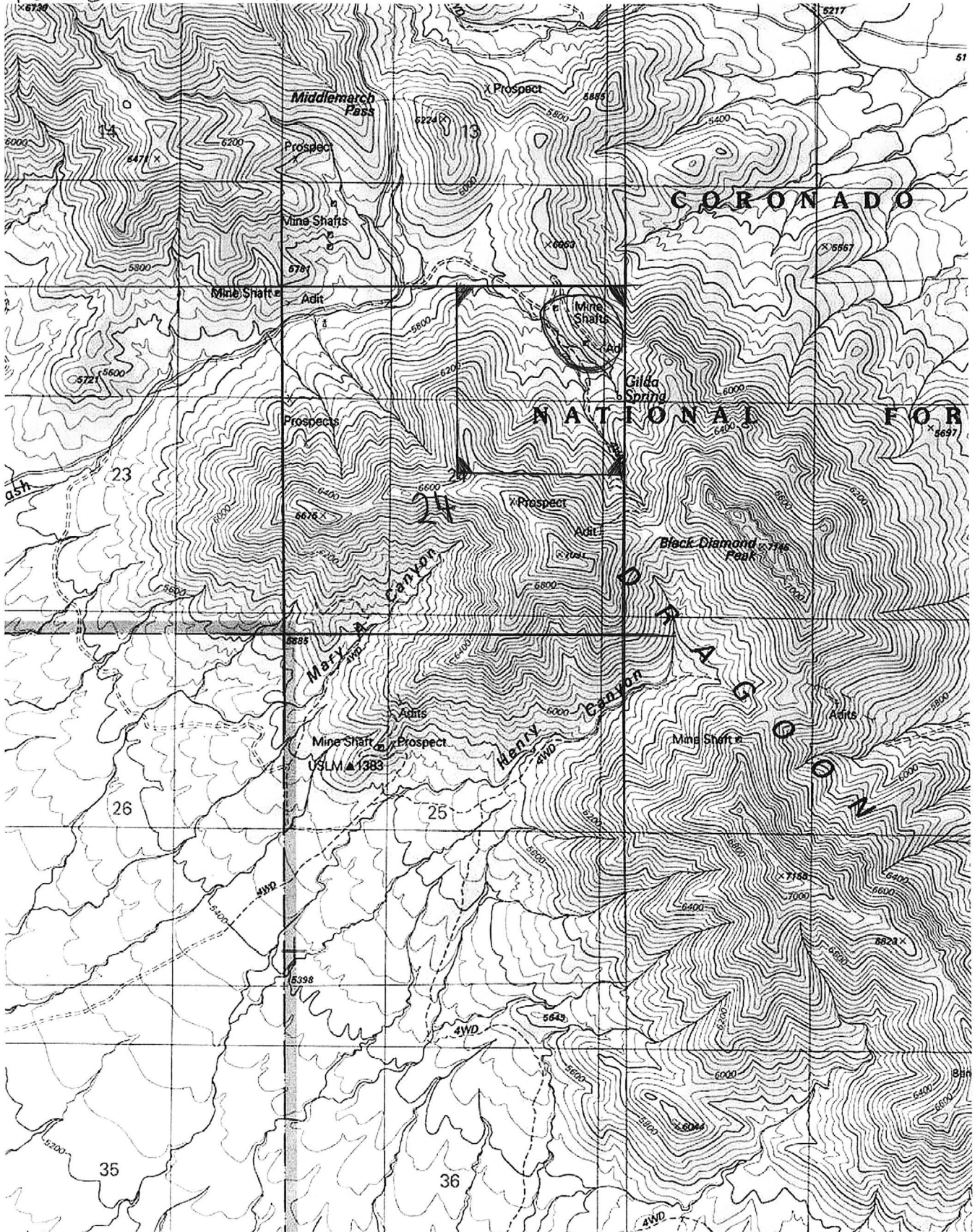

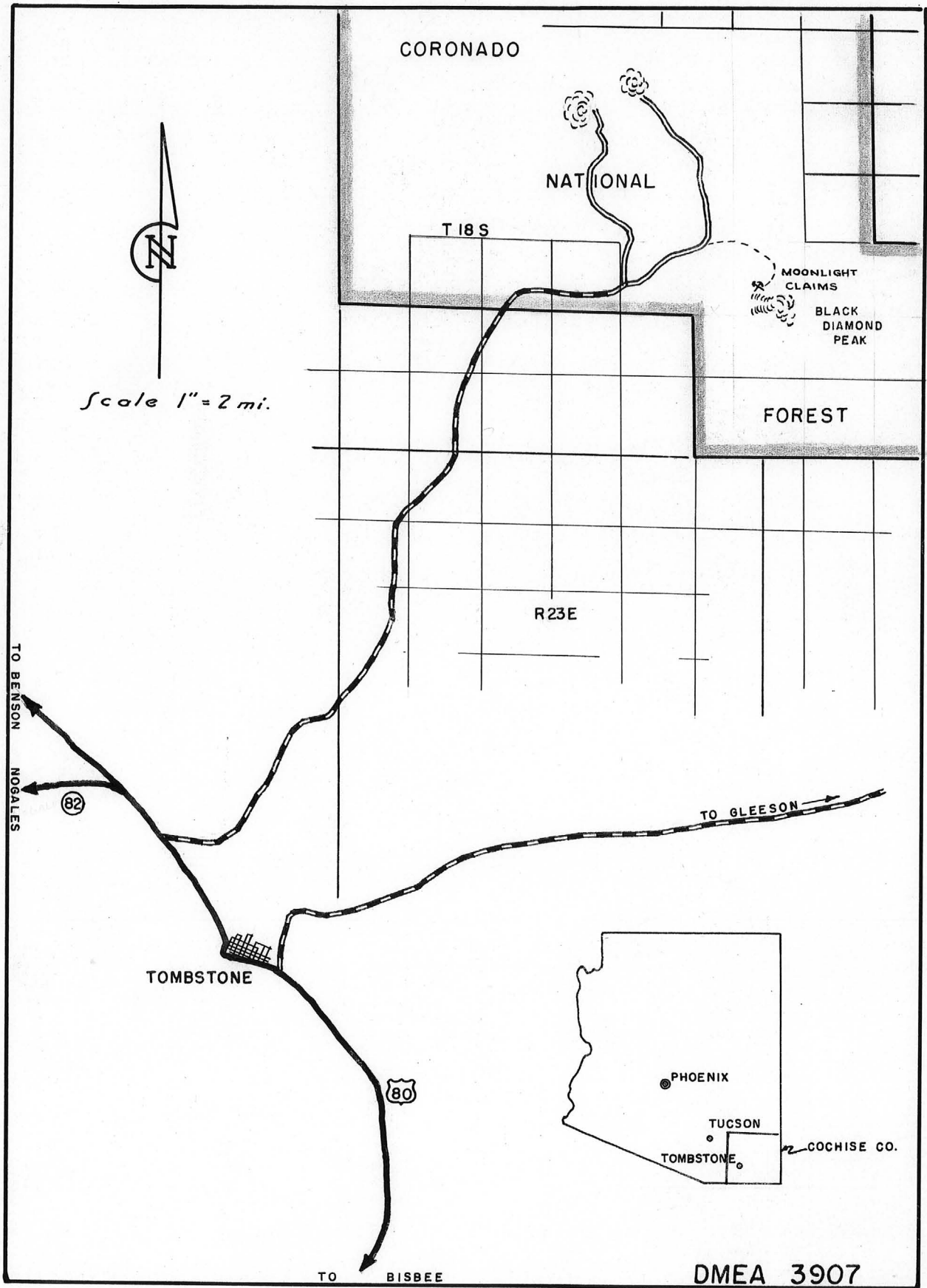


FIG. - 1 - LOCATION MAP, MOONLIGHT CLAIMS NOS. 2 & 3

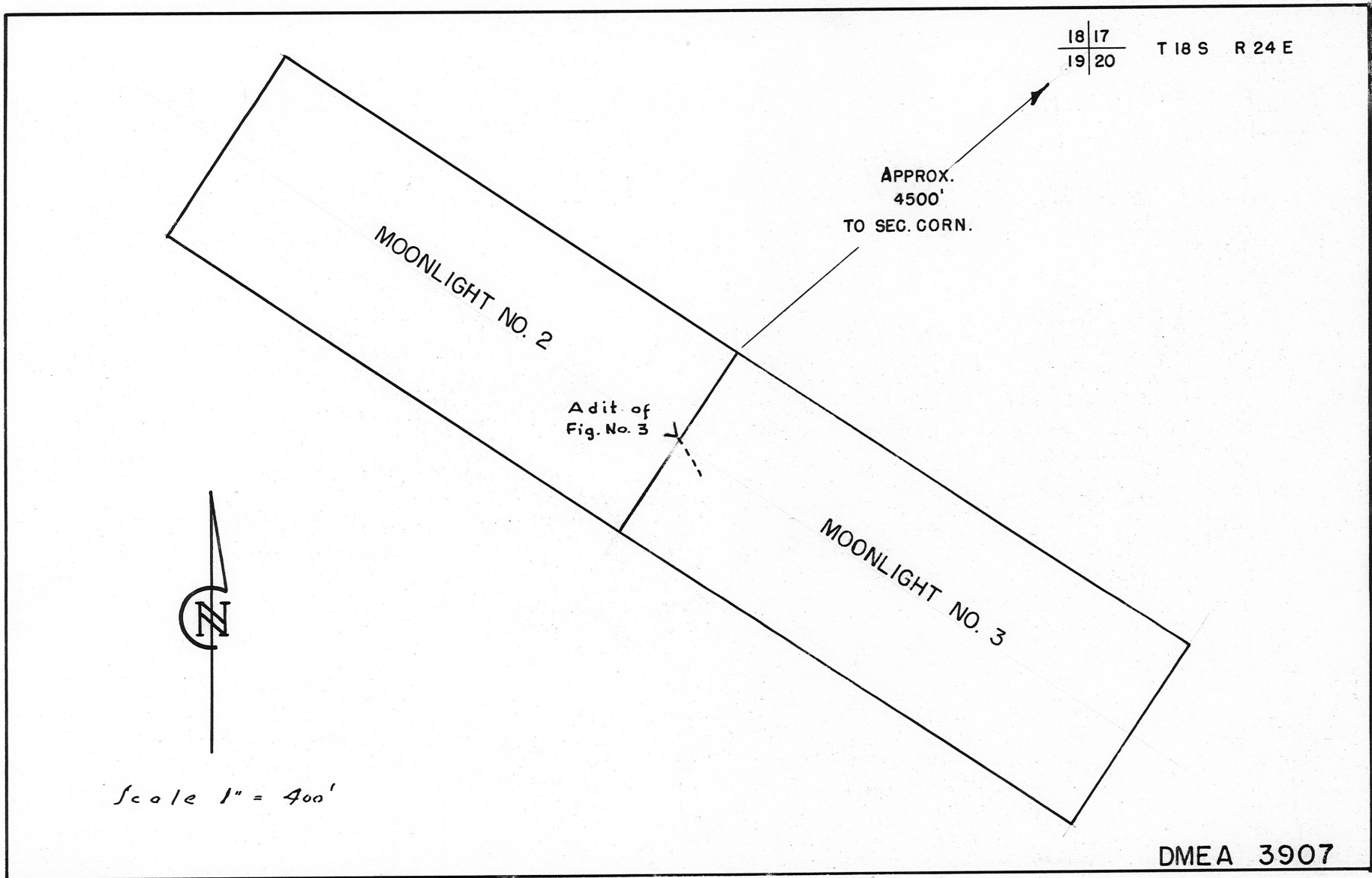
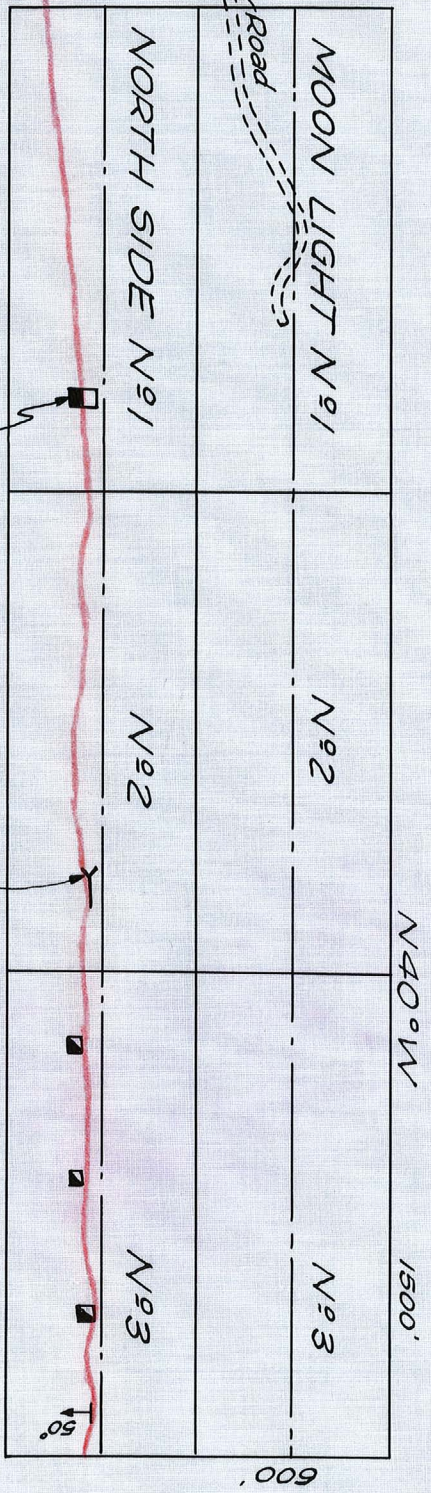


FIG. - 2 - CLAIM MAP, MOONLIGHT CLAIMS, COCHISE CO. ARIZONA

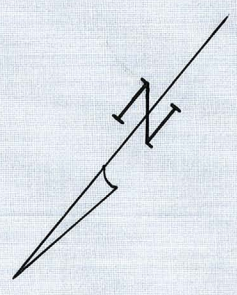
