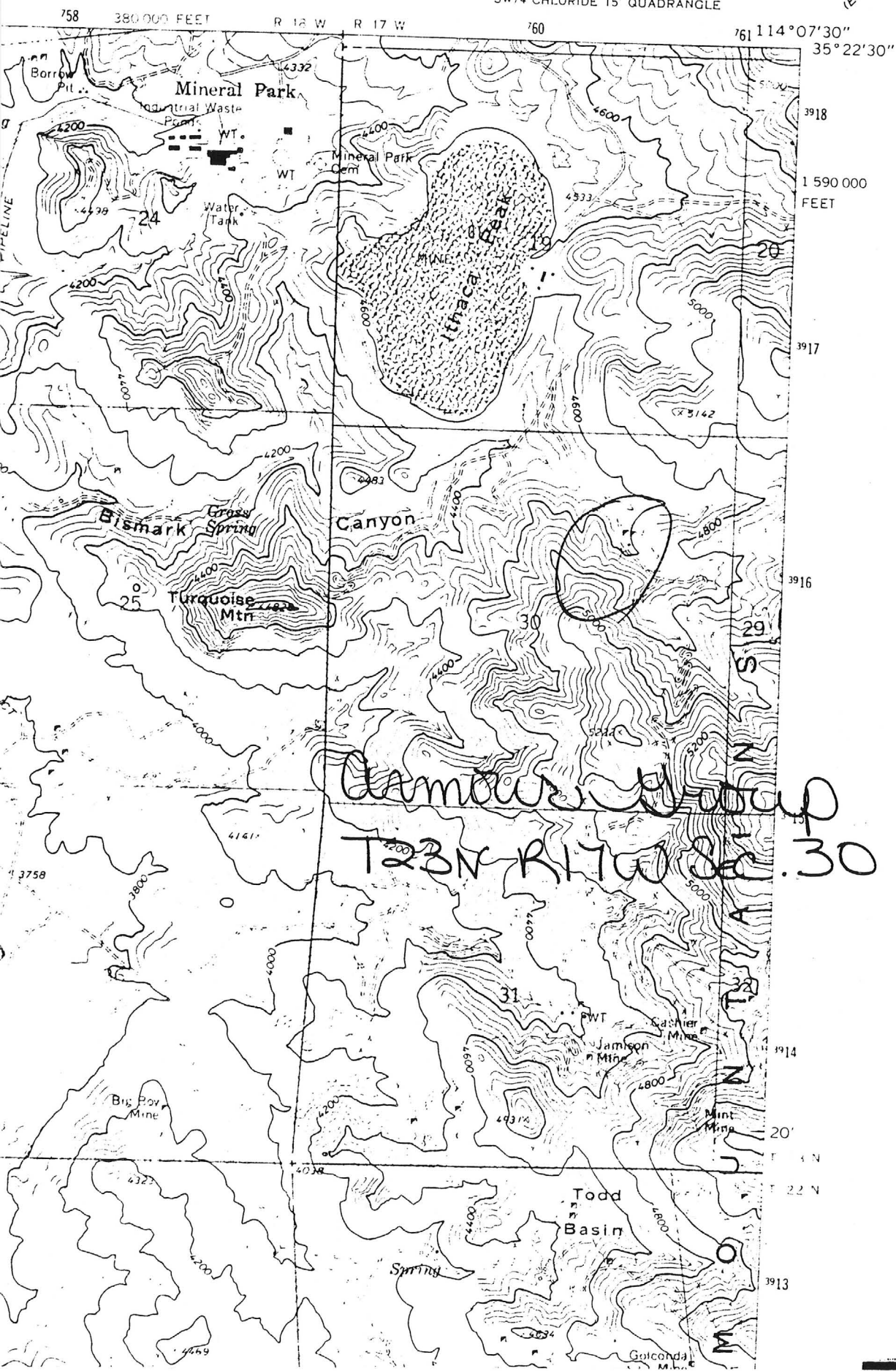

The Armour Group is located about 22 miles ^{NW} from Kingman by way of Mineral Park and 30 Miles by way of Stockton Hill . A road does not go right up to the present workings.

This property is being worked by Chas. Toos and Chas Graham . Mr Toos has been working alone and the past year drove a 500 foot tunnel, to cut a vein which outcrops on the hill some 500 feet above. He has cut a vein which Mr Toos thinks is the Armour vein. At the point of intersection a nice highgrade bunch of copper-lead ore was found, but this is thinning out now and not so much shown.

Mr Toos now expects to raise on the vein which above is a 5 foot quartz vein which he claims carry \$35.00 per ton in gold-silver.

Mr Toos is not doing anything at the present, due to the fact his pardner is a very sick man and in the hospital.
