

SUMMARY


A local resident of the B Bar B Ranch development area in Apache Junction was to inquire about mineral vs. surface rights on land in the area. He lives on 7.5 acres that was patented in 1958 as a small tract entry homestead. The area of this and other small tract homesteads is where the Arpad Claim Group was once located. The Arpad group of 34 claims was surveyed for patent for the Young Mines Company Limited between March 12 and April 7, 1923. The claims never went to patent. According to the small tract patents the minerals were reserved to the Federal Government, but not subject to location under the General Mining Laws except under special provisions to be established by the Secretary of the Interior.
