KAP WR 4/1/83: Frank Beaversdorff was in and explained an error in a previous conversation - see note of, KP WR 7/16/79. He went on to explain that Kennecott had overstaked him and that their prior date on an affidavit of labor is in error. He further stated he would supply a letter for the Beaver Rock Mine explaining the situation and that he had a good title to the claims.

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NJN WR 1/6/84: Frank Beaversdorf, owner of the Beaverock #1-12, <sup>Pinal</sup>~~Gila~~ County, visited. He reported that no one will buy his concentrates or metallic bars. Most potential buyers tell him they are not interested due to the lack of contained precious metals. Mr. Beaversdorf is convinced they all wish to deny him of making a living so they can take over his property. Mr. Beaversdorf also reported theft of ore from his property.

KP WR 1/12/79: Requested information on the details of precious metals refining as shown in the International Nickel Film, he is still trying to chemically treat his ore (gold)? 1/8/79 a.p.

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CH WR 11/14/79: Mineral I.D.'s 1. Olinene basalt with marcasite, pyrrhotite & arsenopyrite (tentative) and 2. a specimen that Beversdorf said came from a vein west of the leach operations of Duval's Mineral Park mine N. of Kingman. It looks like a furnace product. Send to Bob O'Haire for identification.

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WR KP 11-18-77 - Frank H. Beaversdorf, 3033 E. Van Buren, Space 49, Phoenix, 267-1982, DBA Beavorock Group #1-12 on the Gila River near Florence in the Florence District. He exhibited a specimen of what he reported to be high alumina material. Although he had hoped the material to be of interest for its  $Al_2O_3$  content, the rock contains far too much free and combined silica to be alunite. One analysis gave +20%  $Al_2O_3$  and approximately 68%  $SiO_2$ . It was suggested he contact some of the ceramic companies as to their possible interest in the material. Mr. Beaversdorf also has attempted to evaluate placer material on his claims. He claims to have screened the placer material, washed it with  $HCl$ ,  $H_2SO_4$  and  $HNO_3$ , panned it and recovered a concentrate of 52 oz Au/ton. It was suggested he treat the concentrate with the acids instead of the head ore and compare the results. A map of his claims and a spectrographic analysis of the "high alumina" material were provided for the files.

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WR KP 12/9/77 - Frank Beaversdorf brought in what he hoped was a good grade of feldspar. The sample, however, was mostly quartz. He plans on continuing to prospect and sample copper outcrops on his Beavorock Group.  
2/3/78 ap

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KP/WR 7/16/79 - Discussed adverse claim locations with Frank Beaversdorf. He believes Kennecott Copper Corp. has located claims on ground already located by himself. However, a copy of Kennecott's affidavit of labor lists claims which predate Mr. Beaversdorf. It is not known whether the Kennecott claims involve all or just a part of the Beavorock Group, Pinal Co.

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KAP WR 2/20/81: Frank Beaversdorf reported he has found outcrop rock which he says runs 1500 tr.oz/ton silver. He reports the sample is from his Beavorock claims. The sample exhibited was good looking leached outcrop material.

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MG WR 5/21/82: Mr. Clyde L. Mott, 1802 N. 57th Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85035, was in to discuss the Beavorock 1-20 claim group in Pinal County. He and some other investors (?) may buy the property. I called the Phoenix office and obtained file information for him; also suggested several registered geologic consultants.





This is a most unusual 'host' rock. It is amazing to say the least that such values can be detected in such hard rock. This should be a good indicator to the real valuable material in this area where you found this rock. There should be a natural concentrate such as black sands in the same vicinity. Black sands are the most ideal material to extract such values with our process. I would suggest that you get me a sample of the sands in that area and have it tested. I think you will be amazed at what you find.

All quantities shown in 'ounces per ton'.

Spectrographic reports must be given in a range rather than an exact figure. However, the spectrograph is greatly advantageous in that it detects elements that could be overlooked in other methods, especially those of trace, or near trace, amounts. The above figures are not indicative of values obtainable by conventional extraction methods. Most samples containing the platinum group metals are of a 'complex' nature. In the make-up of these 'complexes' are many 'unstabes' that tend to outweigh the 'stable' portion of these elements and act to suppress, or even prevent, the extraction of the 'stabes'.
