

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


Fig. 22-Big Four Mine, Swisshelm Mts., Cochise County, Arizona

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


Fig. 23-No. | Adit, Big Four Mine, Swisshelm Mts. Cochise County, Ariz.

THE BIG FOUR GROUP OF TUNGSTEN CLAIMS

COCHISE? COUNTY ARIJONA

The "Big Four" is a group of four claims located on the west slope of the Swisshelm mountains, about eight miles in an easterly direction from Elfrida, Arizona. A epidote and garnet dyke, 10to 50 feet wide, carrying sheelite and running southeast and northwest, occurs in a granite and lime contact and crops on the surface for a distance of about 1200 feet.

Near the eeast end of the contact and dyke cropping, a crosscut tunnel 400 feet in length, driven through the granite, penetrates this garnet dyke for a distance of 75 feet at a depth below the surface of about 250 feet; this crosscut did not reache the lime contact. There is a drift east from this crosscut for about 75 feet along the granite and garnet contact; another crosscut runs into the garnet **dyke** and to the lime contact at this point and shows the dyke to have a width of about 30 feet. Several assays taken in this crosscut shows values of from 34/100 to 48/100 W03. No assays were taken in the main crosscut but the garnet dyke shows sheelite under the lamp as far as it was penetrated--a distance of about 75 feet.

About 500 feet west of the tunnel and, owing to the contour of the ground, about on a level with it, the garnet dyke crops strongly and shows sheelite under the lamp for a width of over 50 feet. No assays were taken. This cropping continues for about 300 feet. Some 200 feet farther west the garnet dyke again occurs in the granite and lime contact and shows a width of from 10 to 25 feet. Assays taken from this cropping give returns of 28/100 and 34/100 W03.

A lower tunnel about 600 feet in length was drive apparently to cut the garnet dyke at a point **about** 700 feet west of the 400 feet crosscu This lower tunnel has a depth of nearly 400 feet under the upper one. This work was all done years ago trying to find a copper mine. The lower tunnel has not reached the garnet dyke nor the lime contact but it is apparently within a very few feet of it. This tunnel is open and is in good shape but there is no track in it.

It would be comparatively inexpensive to prove whether or not this prospect would develope into a commercial tungsten mine. This could be done by continuing the lower tunnel to the lime and granite contact and then drifting east under the big garnet showing on the surface.

About 3 miles of a well-laid out wagon road was built up the canyon to the mouth of the lower tunnel. It is in fair condition and could be made into a good truck road for a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars. This road connects with a good road to Elfrida.

The expenditure of about \$5000 on this prospect has the possibility of developing ore sufficient to justify the building of a 500 ton mill.
