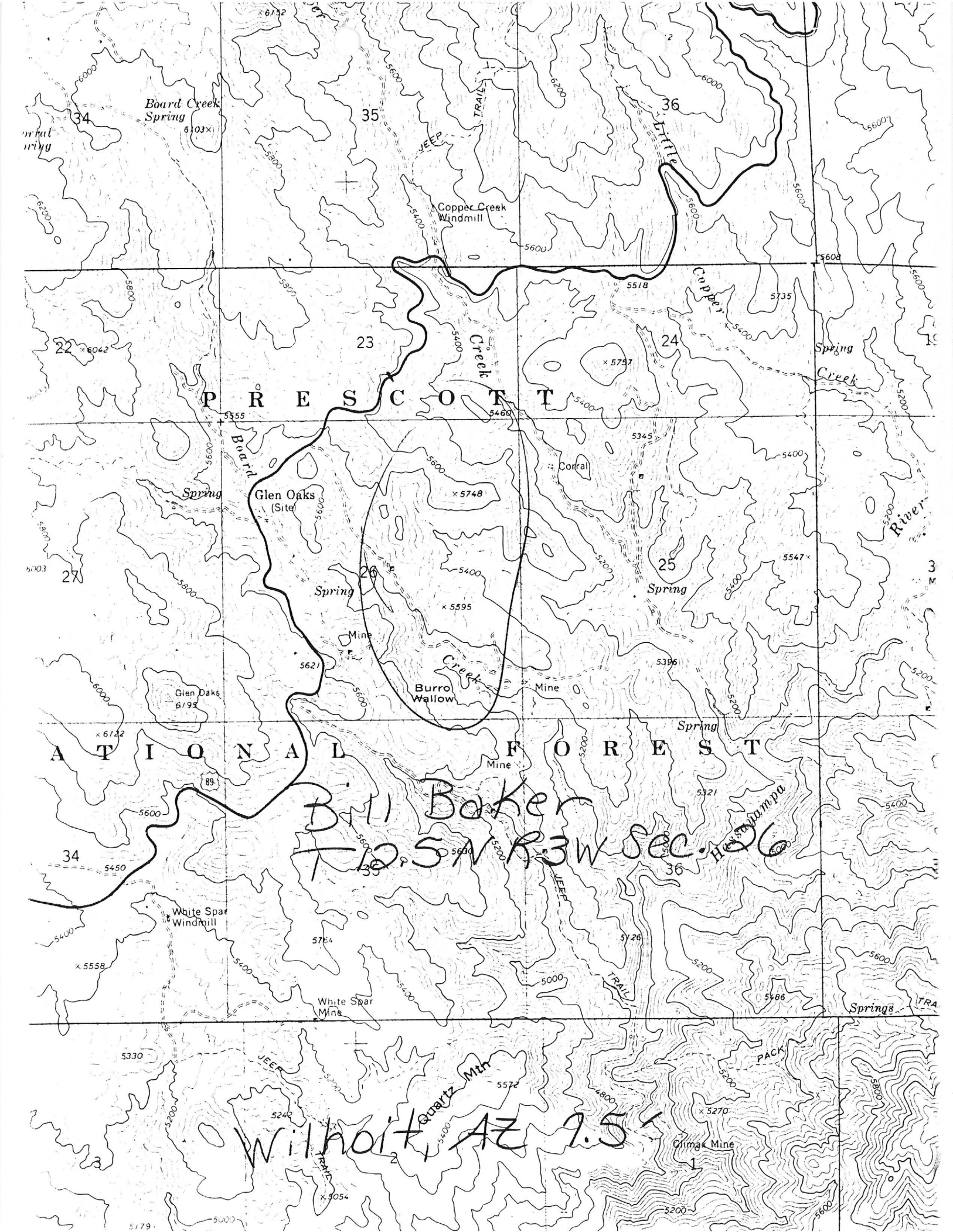

There is not much to be said about this property as it has very little development work done.

The property is located 12 miles down the Whitespar Highway from Prescott and about 3/4 mile off the road. It consists of three claims and owned by Mr Bill Baker. The formation is the Bradshaw Granite and in a well timbered rolling topography.

There is a short tunnel driven along the strike of a fractured zone for a distance of 85 feet and from the bottom of this tunnel a winze was sunk for 27 feet.

The fractured zone is approximately 10 feet wide and has some iron and manganese mineralization .

In the winze there are a few spots of lead ore and Mr Baker says they carry well in silver.

The part of the property across the wash from the house, that Baker thought may be a big shovel gold property is not encouraging. It is out in the solid granite . I advised Mr Baker to forget it.
