

NJN WR 10/11/85: The Black Cat (f) La Paz County is currently being developed by the C.J. International Ventures Inc. (c). Two members of the joint venture C. J. International Ventures, 9149 Ohio Avenue, Sun Lakes, Arizona 85224 visited. They were Wilbert Wax and Jim Anderson. They reported they were having claim problems with Mike Sansome. After those are cleared up they plan to start a cyanide heap leach operation.

NJN WR 5/2/87: Joe Rameriz of the Mine Inspector's Office reported that C. J. International Ventures Inc's (card) past activity at the Black Cat (file) La Paz County included setting up a well, crushing and screening plant and various cement tanks and leaching vats. The equipment was set up and some crushing done but no leaching took place.

NJN WR 2/26/88: Larry Vernon reports that C. J. International Ventures (card) conducted two tank leach tests at the Black Cat (file) La Paz County last year.



The Arizona Department of Health Services (Department) is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Arizona Compilation of Rules and Regulations (A.C.R.R.) Title 9, Chapter 20, Article 2.

The Department has received a complete application for a Groundwater Quality Protection Permit and has prepared tentative determinations regarding the permit.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of A.C.R.R. Title 9, Chapter 20, Article 2 regulations, the Director proposes to issue a Groundwater Quality Protection permit to the following applicant subject to certain special and general conditions.

Groundwater Quality Protection Permit No. G-0002-15

The applicant will operate a mining and milling operation which will recover gold through heap leaching with cyanide and/or thiourea solutions. The facility is located in the Granite Wash Mountains, approximately 3 miles southwest of Harcuvar, Arizona. Depth to water in a nearby mine shaft is 85 feet. There is little usage of the groundwater in the Ranegras Plain Basin, the major usage being agricultural. The facility is designed with adequate overflow protection, and will have three downgradient monitor wells, as well as a leak detection/collection system for the leach pad.

The Administrative Record, which includes the application, draft permit conditions and other relevant documents, is available for public review Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the address below. A copy of the draft permit may be obtained by calling or writing to the address below.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations or request a public hearing pursuant to A.C.R.R. Title 9-20-223.C should submit their comments or request in writing within thirty (30) days from the date of this notice, either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this notice will be considered in the formulation of the final determinations regarding the application. If the response to this notice indicates a significant degree of public desire for a public hearing, the Director shall hold one in accordance with A.C.R.R. Title 9-20-223.C. A public notice of such hearing will be issued at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing. A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing.

The Director will finalize a determination on the permit within thirty (30) days following the last date on which comments may be submitted.
