SUMMARY

Brian Siefker explained that he has purchased two claims located near Dewey from Paul Zelnor. The claims, Blue Silver Number 1 and Blue Silver Number 2 are located in the N, Sec. 31, T.14N., R.2E., Yavapai County. They appear to correspond to an Yavapai County AzMILS unknown, AzMILS 655.

Mr. Siefker, a California Real Estate Broker, indicated he plans to mine gem quality azurite from a 2.5 foot wide vein which he claims is all azurite, but not all gem quality.

He went on to explain that he no mining experience and bought the claims for an investment and future small ranch site after he gets a patent. He reported that Paul Zelnor had mined azurite with a backhoe along a trench on the vein. The trench is reported to be about 100 feet long and 15 feet at the deepest. He was selling the best azurite for gems and lessor quality material for pigment and decorative rock.

Yavapai AzMILS needs to be modified with Blue Silver 1 & 2 as the PRINAME, Prospects 15 as ALTNAME1, Dev Deposit as the CURSTAT, Gem as COM1, Azurite as MODI1, Copper as COM2, and Oxide as MODI2.
