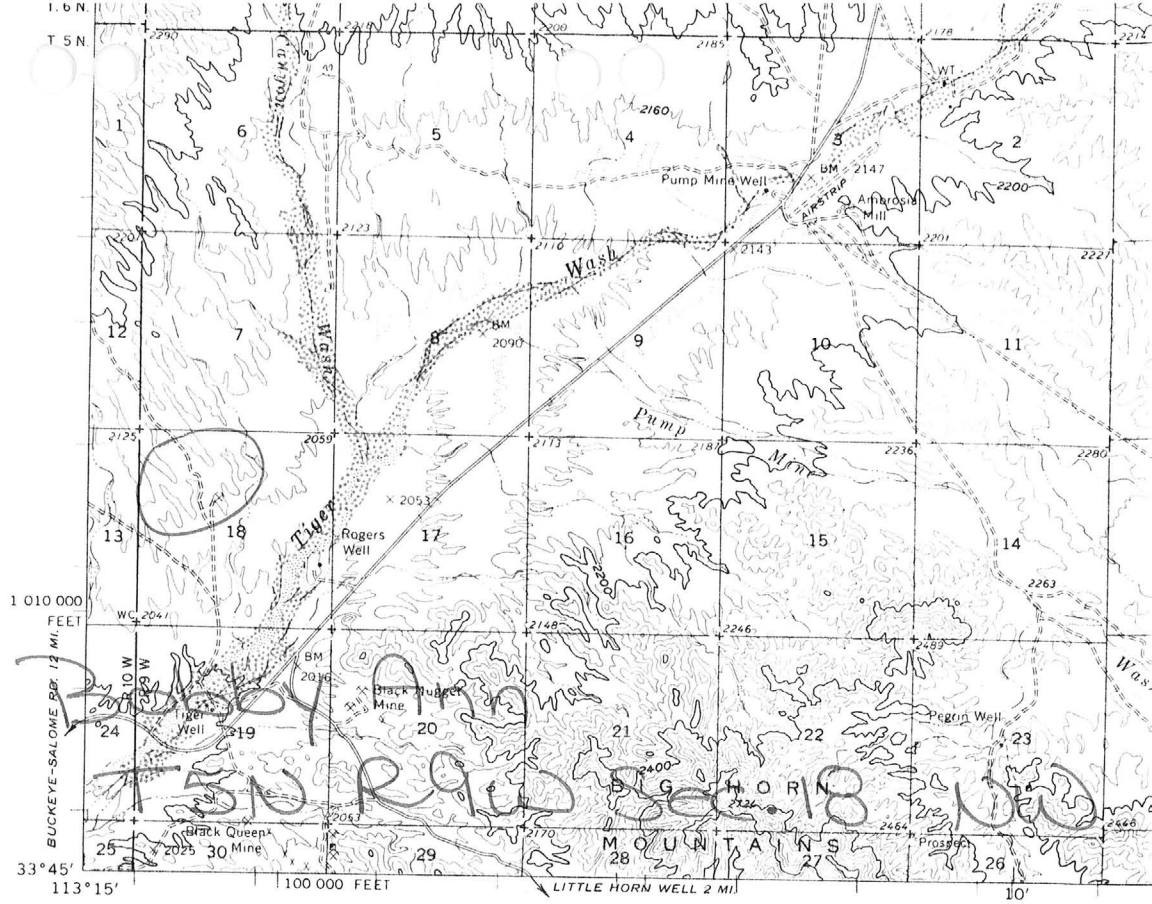

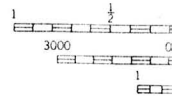
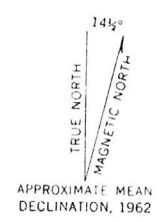

Gentlemen:

Mr. Hughie H. York, 1137 East Portland Street, Phoenix, is making application for supplemental gasoline for a 1936 Ford coupe to be used in further development of his property, the Bobby Ann Mine, which is located about 17 miles southwest of Aguila. This is a copper property developed by a 50 foot shaft and some other surface developments indicating a commercial ore body.

In order to carry out this work Mr. York will find it necessary to come to Phoenix twice a month for supplies and other business connected with the mine and, in addition, will require two trips a week from the mine to Aguila for supplies of water and other supplies needed at the mine.

This operation is for essential war minerals and I can certify as to the need of gasoline.
