Description: Topog. & Geog.

Low, rolling hills with moderate slopes and shallow washes. Arid climate and scanty, desert vegetation. Elevation approximately 3700 feet above sea level. The property lies just beyond the northern tip of the Black Hills, and very near the drainage divide between the Florence-Coolidge and San Pedro valleys.

Mine Workings: Amt. & Condition

To predominant country rock in the area is a coarse-grained g uit ich is cut by numerous r'al kes. These dykes are more on less and run in a NW-SE Geology & Mineralization direction. Covering most of the property is an extensive series of east west mineralized cross fractures which in many places are directly adjacent to narrow intrusions of diabase. The veins formed along these cross fractures are marked by heavy quartz mineralization. At some points the quartz is almost barren, while at other places it carries con siderable quantities of galena, chalcopyrite and wulfenite. Leached portions of the veins show heavy hematite residues. The gold and silver values are evidently carried in the lead and Ore: Positive & Probable, Ore Dumps, Tailings iron sulphides and their residual products. Although gold values are high in some of the ore, practically no free gold is visible in hand specimens. the wulfenite evidently obscuring it entirely. Rich ore from similar veins on adjoining ground invariable shows a considerable wulfenite content. None of the veins can be traced on the surface for a great distance; but the fractures do cross the rhyolite dykes, although mineralization seems to be light or lacking within the dyke limits. Mine, Mill Equipment & Flow Sheet Dips are variable, but uniformly steep. There are showings of ore at various points, but no blocked out tonnage. Development not sufficient for this. Vein widths vary from 18 inches to eight feet.

There is no equipment of any sort on the property.

Road Conditions, Route

Go east From Florence on Winkelman road. Turn south on county highway at point 16 miles out where sign reads "Barkerville". Follow this road approximately 14 miles and turn left where sign points to Mountain View Mine. This road leads directly into property, a distance of a little over three miles. Easy road all the way.

Water Supply

No water has been developed on this property, but there is a good supply on two adjoining properties, and water for domestic purposes could undoubtedly be had here without much work or expense. A more detailed study would be necessary in order to estimate the possibilities of quantities sufficient for industrial use.

Brief History This property has been only recently acquired by the present owner. Former holders have made very little effort to develop it, as shown by the small amount of workings listed upon reverse side of page. The ground directly adjoins the Niemeyer holdings where high grade shipping ore has been developed to a depth of more than 100 feet, and where good ore is still available. The main Niemeyer workings are situated not more than 700 or 800 feet away from this property line, directly to the west and on a vein of identical character. Special Problems, Reports Filed

The present owner is financially unable to carry out any great amount of development work, and the ore exposed in surface showings is not sufficiently high in grade to pay for such work.

Remarks

In view of the showings developed in the adjoining property, and the fact that surface indications on the Bonanza ground are even more promising, it should not require more than a small expenditure to prove or disprove the presence of equally valuable ore deposits on this ground. The property is crossed by a main of the El Paso Natural Gas Co.
