MEMORANDUM

To: Frank P. Knight

Re: Barite deposit north of Patagonia

On Nov. 2, 1960, John Bradshir, Box 816, Patagonia, supplied the following information:

Mr. Bradshir is interested in a barite deposit in Temporal Canyon, 3 miles north of Patagonia.

The approximate location of the deposit is Sec. 25, T. 21 S., R. 15 E., Santa Cruz County. From Patagonia take the Temporal Canyon road for a distance of about 3 miles north to the deposit.

Mr. Bradshir is afraid that the barite is not much good as it is coated with iron and comes in very small bunches. However, he suggests the possibility that it might be milled.
