### 5. Summary of information received, comments, etc.:

Mr. Peters reported that Mike Cook is no longer involved in the property and the relationship between himself and Mr. Cook has become adversarial. He explained that he feels Mr. Cook intentionally led him on to investing time and money into the property and purchase of a pilot processing plant to the tune of \$40,000. Further, that the geochem and assay results from Horizon Labs were fictional and that Cook repeatedly lied about the lab results. Reportedly the pilot plant to be built by Horizon was never made.

Harrison Matson visited the property and obtained some samples for assay. The results were not good.

Owners Mike Cook, Wayne and Brinon Peters, and Robert Stevens are the prospector/locators have been actively prospecting on the northeast side of Dos Cabezas Peaks. They stated by taking 35 mm infared photographs in an effort to pick out plants with higher mineral value. They followed up taking geochem samples. However, the lab results of the analysis must be questioned because the background values reported were high enough to be good ore grade mineralization (0.1 tr oz Au/ton). Further, a hand picked sample ran 11.18 tr oz Au/ton and 36.40 tr oz Ag/ton.

Messrs Cook and Peters report they can trace a multiple vein system consisting of quartz vein in a NW-SE direction. The veins dip 18 degrees to the southwest under the peaks near the line between vegetation and the bare rock peaks.


They have requested we visit the property with them.

### MAP


