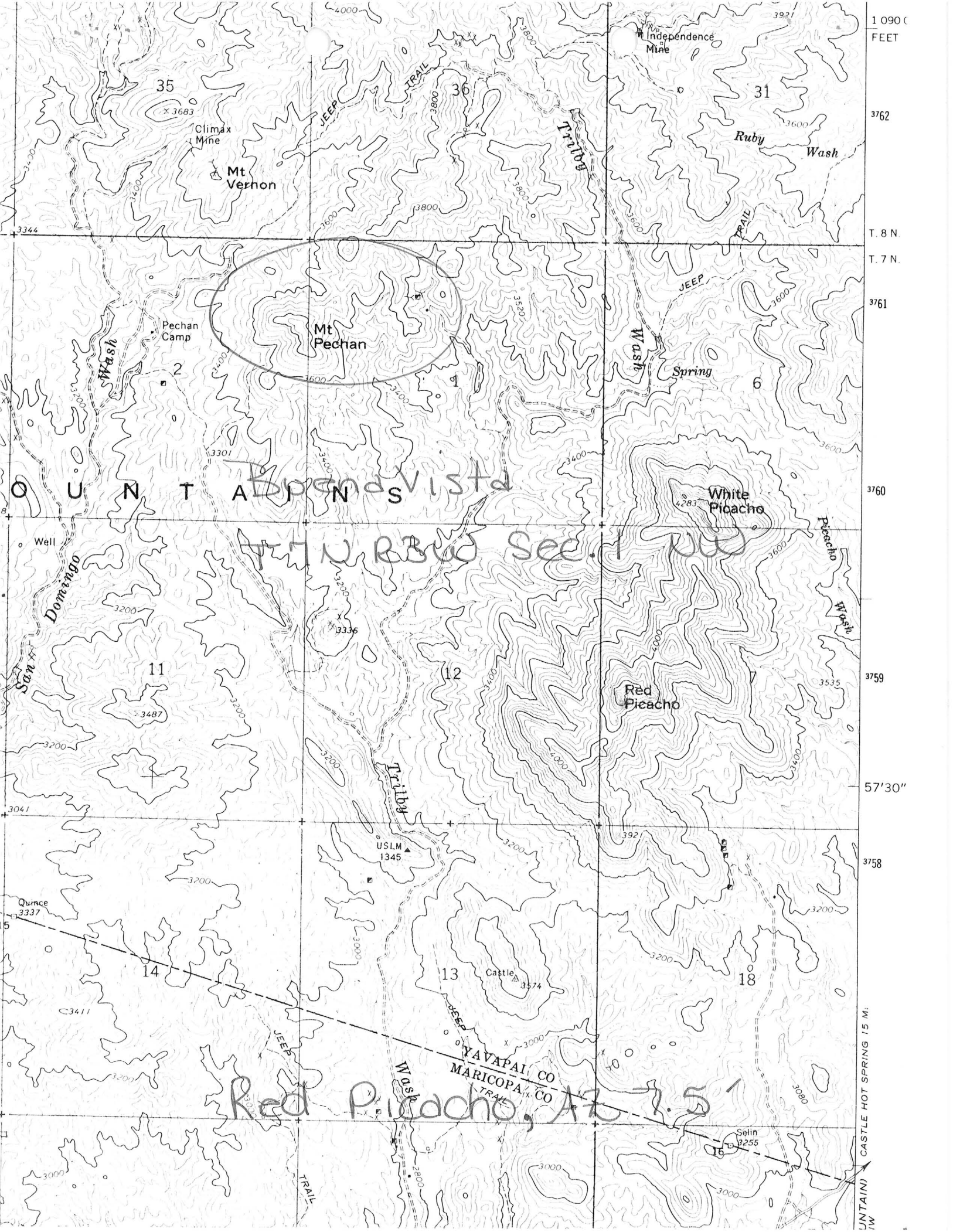

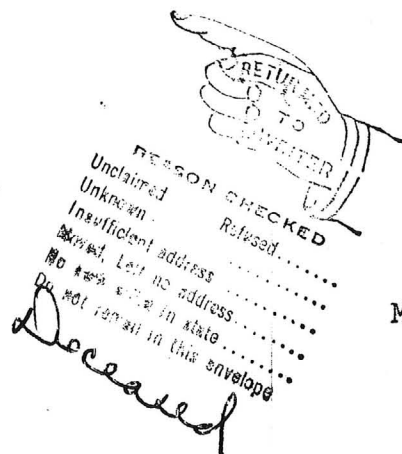

23. Geology & Mineralization Contact between schist and hematite apparently. Schist is over 100' thick and runs the country for several miles. Contact mineralization is noticeable thru-out length. Quartz varies greatly in width. There is always some garnet on contact. Scheelite seems to occur where silicification and garnetization are strongest. Some copper stains show attending scheelite.

24. Ore: Positive & Probable, Ore Dumps, Tailings None

24-A Vein Width, Length, Value, etc. None

25. Mine, Mill Equipment & Flow Sheet None

26. Road Conditions, Route Fair road to Trilby Creek. Go 9 miles N. from Morristown on Castle Hot Springs Road. Turn west on Trilby creek road 4 miles. Stop at Patchins Camp and inquire for mine.

28. Brief History District has been prospected for gold, silver and copper for 50 years.
