





- 23. Geology & Mineralization is over 100° thick and runs the country for several miles. Contact mineralization is noticeable thru-out length. Quartz varies greatly in width. There is always some garnet on contact. Scheelite seems to occur where silicification and garnetization are strongest. Some copper stains show attending scheelite.
