Location: The mine and mill are located 35 miles north of Globe by way of the Young road, thence 4 miles east.

These men have contracted to treat 6 tons per hour of the ore from the Repelius-Elvert mine, 1/4 mile south of mill. The mill will consist of:

(1) Cedar Rapids 36" Rolling Crusher (Reduction to -2")

(2) Davis Short-stroke, double jaw crusher (Reduction to 3/8")

(3) Classified Swaco 4 deck flat shacking screen, which reduces in 4 stages: -

6" mesh

16" "

(4) Shaker screen to handle -24 mesh

(5) Davis tables (S16) to table screenings.
