The property of the Corporation consists of five contiguous mining claims situate in the San Francisco Mining District, Mohave County, Arizona, known as the Cash Entry Group, located about 1/2 Mile Southwesterly from the Tom Reed mine and mill and having the Carter on the East and the Oatman Queen on the West, both of latter companies having good showings of ore at depth.

The Vein system of the Group is exposed on the surface for about 4000 feet.

The property has a shaft 60 feet deep, and is accessible for working, and surrounded by properties in process of active development.

A map showing the surveyed claims of the Company is attached hereto marked Exhibit B(I) and copies of the Deed to the Corporation of the property described above.

APPLICATION OF CASH ENTRY MINING COMPANY
FOR A STOCK SELLING PERMIT.



To the Arizona Corporation Commission:

1. CASH ENTRY MINING COMPANY is a domestic corporation, organized March 24, 1916, having its principal place of business at Oatman, Ariz., and capitalized for two hundred thousand dollars, divided into two millions shares of stock of the par value of ten cents per share.

2. This corporation is possessed of and owns five lode mining claims situated in the San Francisco Mining District of Mohave County, Arizona, said claims being about one half mile southwesterly from the plant of the Tom Reed Mining Company, a more particular description of such claims and the titles thereto appearing in the files of the Commission in the application for a stock selling permit applied for and received heretofore.

3. Of the capital stock of the corporation, -the Combination group known as Oatman Combination Mining Company owns one million one hundred thousand shares. This stock is not subject to any pooling agreement, -permission to dispose of three hundred thousand shares of the same having recently been granted said Oatman Combination Co.

Of the nine hundred thousand shares remaining in the Treasury of said Cash Entry Co., three hundred and ninety thousand nine hundred and eighty shares have been sold and disposed of by said Company for the sum of five cents per share, total in figures being, -\$19,549.

Of this sum the amounts expended and the objects of such expenditures are as follows:-

Machinery, buildings, etc.,	\$6,000,
Labor and material in shaft, cross cuts, tunnels and development,-	13,549.

4. A vein system exposed for approximately four thousand feet traverses the properties of the applicant and has been prospected to the following extent- shaft three hundred feet in depth, one hundred and fifty feet of cross cutting. The cost of this development was paid for through the sale of stock and is in the amount set forth in Paragraph 3 herein.

5. The diamond drilling method of prospecting, demonstrated to be such a success in the Oatman District offers a new and economical way of prospecting for ore at depth and it is the intention of this Company to pursue a diamond drilling campaign from the three hundred foot level of its shaft. It is believed the sum derived from the sale of stock herein prayed for will sufficiently finance such prospecting.

6. The expenditure of all moneys will be under the direction and supervision of the officers of this Company, the personnel thereof being practically as heretofore shown in 1916. It is represented that the sum of fifteen thousand dollars is necessary to finance the Company and for that purpose the sale of three hundred thousand shares of Treasury stock is proposed.

7. No contract has been made at this writing for the sale of such stock. It is proposed however to sell the entire issue of three hundred thousand shares to the President of the Company for the price of five cents per share.

WHEREFORE, said applicant hereby prays permission to sell three hundred thousand shares of its Treasury stock for the full sum of five cents per share, paying no commissions therefor.


Working shaft about 1000 feet easterly from Aztec shaft of the Tom Reed Company and about 2000 feet southeasterly from Big Jim shaft, two of the richest mines in Oatman. Three veins show on the surface, the formation and mineral characteristics being very favorable for the existence of large bodies of commercially rich gold ore at depth.

The management is confident that the rich *Aztec* vein extends on its strike into the property of the Oatman Combination not far to the east of its working shaft, and that this vein has been drifted on right up to the dividing line.

DEVELOPMENT

A two-compartment shaft has been sunk to a depth of 544 feet and crosscuts from 518-foot level are now being driven both northerly and southerly. October 1, 1916, the northerly crosscut was in about 75 feet and the southerly about 125 feet. A large-sized vein was encountered at a depth of about 100 feet in the shaft, the vein dipping at about 70 degrees, being a contact vein between rhyolite and andesite, apparently over 25 feet in width, having well-fined walls, with a fine looking gouge. This vein is highly mineralized, the average value being about \$4.00 per ton in gold, which, in the Oatman district, is remarkably high so near the surface.

The southerly crosscut should intersect the *Aztec* vein at a greater depth than in the Aztec shaft and show even greater values.






