Current status

Reference: Previous report of January 9, 1973

Equipment: See previous report. A 5 ton dump truck has been added and ore is being trucked to a stockpile area 500 feet from the shaft. Waste is piled in the dump at the shaft collar. A pickup camper is being used for living quarters next to the hoist and work shed.

Operation: Since last visit approximately 250 tons of material has been mined from the shaft, 75-100 tons have been piled in the ore stockpile.

Minerals: An inspection of dumps and stockpiles shows the ore mineral to be gold, some of which is free. Gangue minerals are pyrite, chalcopyrite, limonite, hematite, calcite and siderite, all in quartz.

Vein: Quartz veins vary from 1 to at least 12 inches in width by material seen in dump and stockpile. The shaft is sunk on a breciated quartz vein in a fracture or fissure in quartz monzonite.
