Subject: Preliminary Examination

The lease is owned by ✓ Chesser & Co, Reno, Nevada, ✓ John Chapman Agent, Grand Junction, ✓ Col. It is being operated by Junction Bit and Tool Co. and in charge of Tom Bailey and Henry Kolego, Flagstaff, Arizona.

The property lies on the edge of some low hills on the northwest side of the Little Colorado. The ore deposit is in sand stone which underlies loose soil and other sedimentary materials of varying thicknesses. The ore appeared to be very irregular in thickness and extent and required great care in mining to maintain a commercial grade.

The minerals present are Autinite and Carnotite. Production is at the rate of 100 tons per day of ore averaging .23 % which is shipped to Tuba City

The property is well equipped and appears to be making money. It adjoins a lease held by the Rare Metals Corp.
