

Joel Duffield was to report on his search for a source of white quartz for chemical resistant pool-plaster aggregate. He reported the Climax patented property that straddles the line between Secs. 33 and 34, T.7N.,R.9E. has what he reports to have large, wide barren quartz outcrops. He had photographs that showed large quartz outcrops of greater than 100' in length and 50' in width. He promised better copies for an ADMMR file and didn't leave any copy or allow a machine copy or digital scan or the photos he did exhibit. He believes the property belongs to David Twichell and Virginia Twichell (not husband and wife), but had no address or contact information.

He did not exhibit any samples. He hopes to arrange access with the Forest Service so that he can use small scale mechanized equipment to obtain minimal data as to possible quality and extent of the deposit.

There is some confusion as to the name of the property. Mr. Duffield referred to it as the Denver City but the Denver City is located Sec. 4 of T.6N., R.9E. The property was missed in our original AZMILS compilation. The property will be added to AZMILS as Maricopa 811. A new ADMMR mine file was created.
