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

Mr. Anderson has been prospecting this patented property. It is currently held by an estate.

He exhibited specimens of faintly banded competent, fine-grained, gray marble as well as a number of less competent samples. The limestone-marble deposit is extensively exposed along Whitetail Creek.

It was suggested he examine some commercially available marble tile as examples. Further, it was suggested he produce some polished samples of the material from the deposit.

Although patented, he could not find any indication of past production.
