Geology: The geology is the regular Bradshaw Granites, with Diorites and Schist. There are two veins, 2 feet thick with a strike North-South.

Water: The property is only off 1/4 mile from Castle Creek, so water for mining can be had from there.

Roads: At the present time travel is down Castle Creek wash to the Hot Spring road and into Morrystown, which is tough going.
