20. Number Claims, Title, etc. Eight unpatented lodes, located on Papago Indian Reservation. Title clear.
21. Description: Topography & Geography In the foothills of South Comobabi mountains. One vein cuts through hill where tunnel would give 400 feet of backs.
22. Mine Workings: Amt. & Condition One shaft 115 ft. depth (40 feet of water); 1 shaft 50 ft; 1 shaft 20 ft; 1 drift 25 ft. from 25 ft. level of 50 ft. shaft. About 100 feet of open cut work. All workings open and accessible, except 115 ft. shaft.

23. Geology & Mineralization Principal country rock andesitic porphyry and other porphyry rocks some more acid and some more basic. Granite hills outcrop on north part of property. Veins are both N & S and E & W and cut porphyry and granite alike. Deep shaft is on N & S vein. Ore is oxidized and free milling. Vein width 3 ft. to 6 ft. in places 10 ft.

24. Ore: Positive & Probable, Ore Dumps, Tailings No blocked out ore claimed. Ore showings in practically all of the openings. Dumps at 115 ft. shaft, and 50 ft. shaft 400 to 500 tons. Estimated value \$5.00 to \$6.00. One mill run of one ton recovered \$32.00 at Jaeger mill. Another ton lot concentrated in wet washed 5 lbs. of concentrate assaying \$42,000 per ton.

25. Mine, Mill Equipment & Flow Sheet

26. Road Conditions, Route Five miles off the Tucson-Sells highway. Mine road good, no heavy grades. Can drive to all principal workings.

27. Water Supply 40 ft. of water stands in the 115 ft. shaft and is used for drinking and camp purposes. Believed that plenty of water for small mill can be developed in the shaft by sinking deeper and drifting on vein. The Jaeger shaft, one mile south on same vein has plenty of water for a 30 ton mill.

28. Brief History Located 1932 by J. F. Parr as an original location. Developed as means allowed.

29. Special Problems, Reports Filed Development has reached a stage where hoisting equipment is essential and air drilling equipment should be provided. No engineers reports have been made.

30. Remarks Parr and Cunningham are both experienced miners, capable of working and directing small scale operations. Parr would be interested in taking responsibility for the development of the property and the other two partners would be glad to work on property on grub stake basis until the property was on a producing basis. When sufficiently developed want a small mill.
