NJN WR 8/5/88: Phil Blacet (card) reported that he visited the Cumberland Mine, Yavapai County while working for the USGS and that the property is not a quartz fissure vein as described by Lindgren in USGS Bull 782, but is instead an intrusive pebble or breccia dike. This occurrence is probably the result of a gas phase of the Pine Flat Laramide intrusive. In the collar of the shaft late stage movement can be seen, evidenced by lithic fragments just removed from the wall. Mineralization consists of pyrrhotite containing gold in a matrix of rock flower and pebble breccia. The lithic pebble fragments are not part of the local rocks but probably are exotics from great depths. Obviously Lindgren did not make a field visit to this property.
