



Subject: Field Engineers Report. Personal visit and information from Bud Forcier, drill foreman

Location In Naco Hills. Approximately Sec. 35 -- T 23 S -- R 23 E., approximately 2 miles west of Naco Jct., and from 1/2 to 1 mile N. of Hwy # 92.

Number of Claims No definite information. Was reported by Douglas Dispatch as 181 claims on State land. A recent location.

Owners State of Arizona.

Locators & Lesees Phelps Dodge Copper Corp.

Principal Minerals Exploration for copper.

Principal Present Mining Activity Diamond drilling by Boyles Bros. Drilling Co.

Geology and Mineralization Drill cores show limestone and quartzite, principally limestone. Mr. Forcier also reports encountering clay and silt in the holes.

History None. This is a new prospect.

Review of Operations Boyles Bros. started drilling on Feb. 24, 1960, using 2 diamond drill rigs -- Joy BX core, wire line. 2 holes have been drilled to date, and they are now drilling a third hole. The 2 finished holes were 2700 ft. and 1600 ft. deep respectively, and the third hole is now down to a depth of 1900 ft.

One drill rig is now reported as finished, and the other drill rig, drilling the third hole, will be through next week, at which time drilling is expected to be discontinued according to Mr. Forcier, drill foreman.
