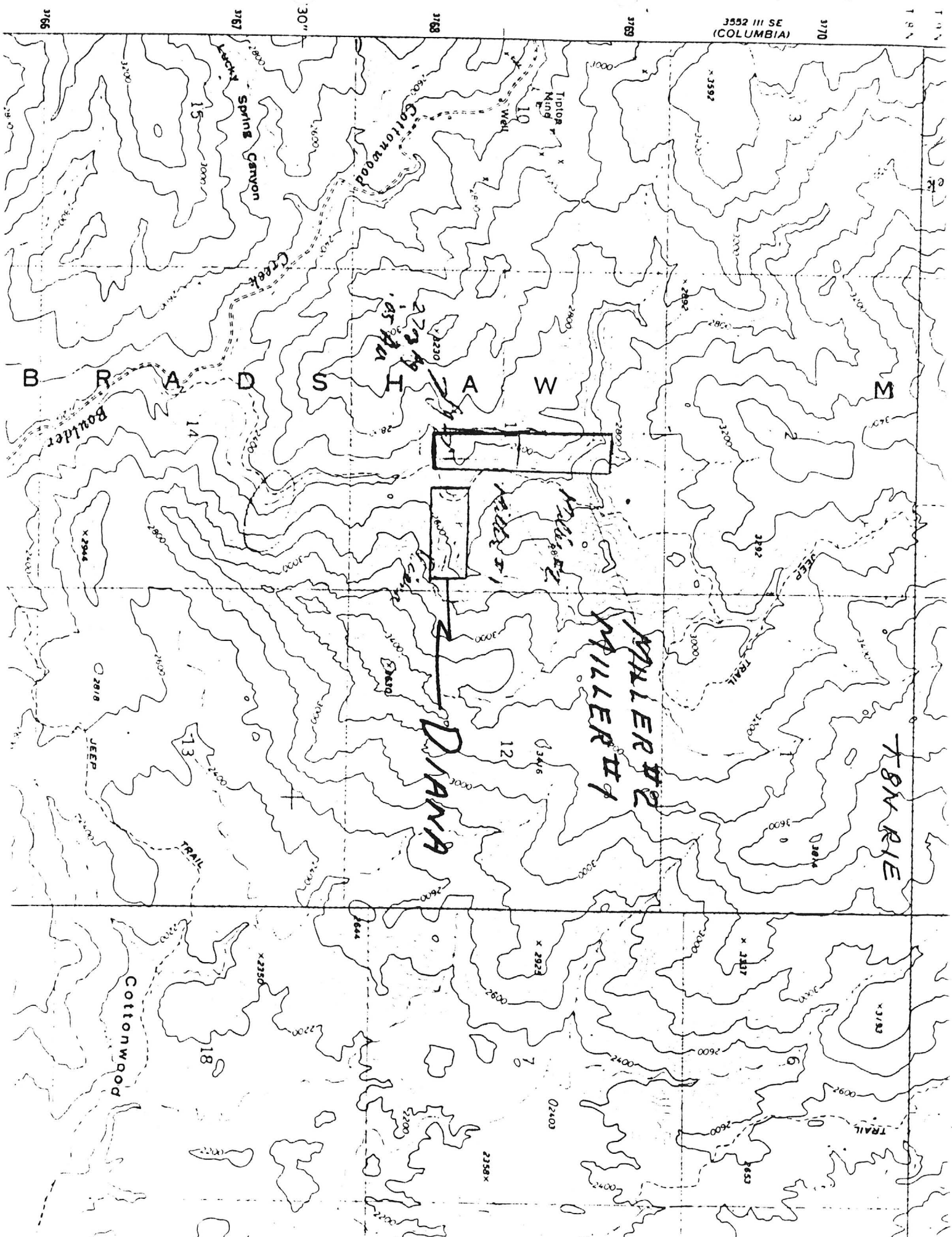

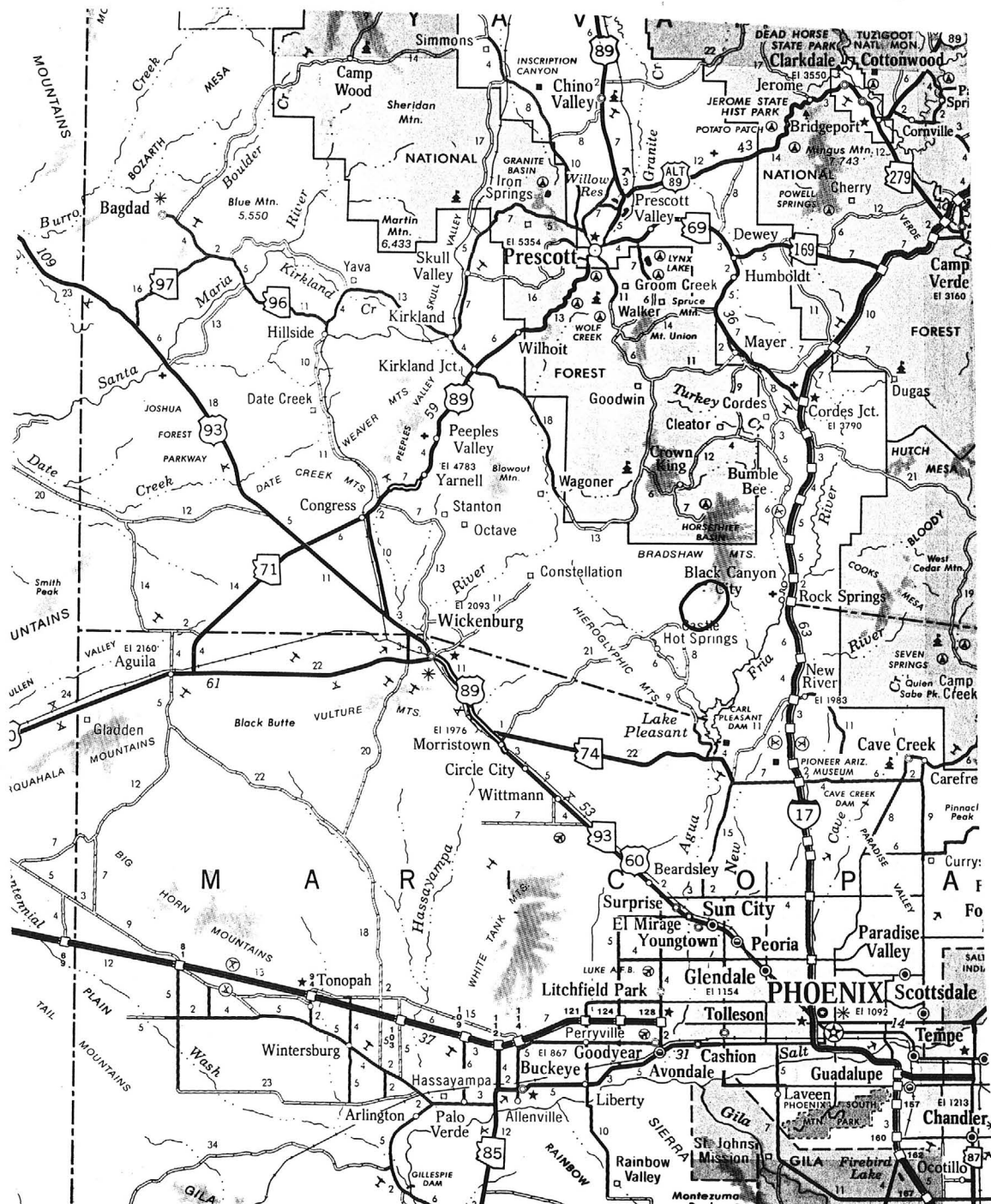

KAP WR 10.29/82: Floyd Miller brought in some samples for examination which contained nothing of interest. He is still prospecting for tungsten occurrences in the area of his Diana Claim, Tip Top District, Yavapai County.

KP WR 5/14/79: He reported he is continuing to prospect his claims, the Diana, Patricia and Susie Group of 6 claims in the Tip Top District, Yavapai County. The commodity of interest is tungsten as wolframite and lesser amounts of scheelite, both as narrow shoots in veins.

KAP WR 8/1/80: Floyd Miller exhibited an excellent sample of wolframite in quartz from his Diana claim in Tip Top District, Yavapai County. Information was obtained for a separate report on the property. (Tungsten)

KAP WR 3/6/81: Floyd Miller reported he is still interested in trying to sell his Diana Claims on Boulder Creek, Tip Top District, Yavapai County. It was explained that it would be necessary for him to do some rudimentary mapping and sampling prior to interesting a source of capital or purchaser in the property.

KAP WR 6/24/81: Assay results of samples taken on Del Hana's claims on the tungsten-antimony prospect on Boulder Creek, called Boulder Creek Mine, Tip Top Dist. Yav. Co. Were received. These claims cover the same location as Floyd Miller's Diana Claims. Assay results were added to this file.

RRB WR 8/21/81: Floyd Miller reports that he should have the equipment to work the Diana Claims, Tip Top District, Yavapai County, next week. He says they'll crush, grind and table the ore to make a tungsten concentrate.

KAP WR 8/21/81: Ray Edwards, 5619 W. Hubbell, Phoenix 85035 explained he is trying to develop Floyd Miller's Diana claims in the Tip Top District, Yavapai County. The claims contain narrow quartz veins with minor wolframite (tungsten mineral). Mr. Edwards admitted that his lack of mining experience is a problem.

KAP WR 1/15/82: A pilot mill run was made on tungsten ore (wolframite in quartz vein material) from Floyd Miller's Diana Claims in the Tip Top District, Yavapai County. The material was processed at the Stutenroth Mill.

KAP WR 3/10/77: Floyd Miller, 1311 N. 32nd Ave, Phoenix 85009, phone 278-1736, has a wolframite occurrence he has prospected near Tip Top. He exhibited some very high grade specimens. The property needs more prospecting.

KP WR 5/13/77: Floyd Miller brought in samples of wolframite from his claims near Tip Top. He had analysis made which reported the samples contain 52% WO₃.

KP WR 1/13/78: Was in to discuss his tungsten prospect near Tip Top. He has had some interest expressed in the property by promoters. The ore minerals are wolframite with small amounts of scheelite. Plans were made to visit the property on January 24, 1978.

KP WR 5/19/78: During office visit was supplied info on assessment work. He had made an agreement with Doug Hoyt, International Mining & Metals to evaluate his tungsten property. Hoyt is reported particularly interested in the flower gold potential of the property.

KP WR 10/24/78: Still working and trying to promote his tungsten claims in the southern end of the Bradshaw Mtns. He has a couple of interested parties that want to evaluate the claims for both tungsten and gold. His primary tungsten mineral is wolframite.

KP WR 8/24/78: Floyd Miller reported that George Schafer had visited his tungsten prospect and told him it needs considerable sampling.

KAP WR 11/24/78: He has apparently interested George Schafer of Prescott into developing his prospect. A company United ____? will supposedly supply equipment and a firm, International Metals, will supply \$50,000.

KP WR 3/28/79: Floyd Miller along with George Schaffer is working to expose veins on the Sue Ann Claims in the Cave Creek District, Maricopa County.

18. Misc. Notes: Deposit consists of an east-west striking wolframite in quartz vein. Miller reports the wolframite runs in stringers 1/2" to 6" wide in the quartz. Specimens he has shown confirm this. He also reported the mineralized zone is much wider (8 feet in at least one place) and carries scheelite. One assay over 8' of width covering both wolframite and scheelite assayed 6.3% WO₃. The property needs a visit by Department engineers. It may have potential as an important tungsten occurrence. Old workings consist of pits and a shaft on the vein. It is rumored that \$50,000 worth of tungsten ore was produced during WWII.

Filing for Recordation Rejected Mining Claim Deemed Abandoned and Void

In accordance with the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 and the regulations in 43 CFR 3833, on June 8, 1977 you filed for recordation a notice of location for the Diana mining claim. This notice was assigned serial number A MC 7778. The claim was located March 10, 1977.

In addition to requiring recordation of your mining claim, the Act and the regulations require that prior to December 30 of each year following the calendar year in which the claim was located, you must file in the proper Bureau of Land Management Office evidence of annual assessment work performed during the preceding assessment year or a notice of intention to hold the mining claim, 43 CFR 3833.2-1, copy enclosed.

An affidavit of labor performed or a notice of intention to hold the claim listed above was not received in this office prior to December 30, 1978. The failure to file one of these instruments within the time allowed is deemed conclusively to constitute abandonment of the claim and it is void, 43 CFR 3833.4.

Subject to valid intervening rights of third parties or the United States, void or abandoned claims may be relocated and, based on new location date, the new certificate of relocation may be refiled within 90 days, accompanied by a \$5 service fee.
