

N.B. As I have told you previously, frequently in order to get the best looking applications under way first, those not so good have to be delayed and when so much time passes, it either means a good deal of correspondence with the field engineers or applicant, or that it did not look good enough to ~~push~~ push and others creep in ahead.

Every time we push some loan we think is good, we displace something like this one and give it a seat further back.

I hear that 12 or 15 new examiners have been added to the Washington office, and that may help quite a bit. The big delays now are plain lack of physical help... but the conservative attitude is still with us. I believe the proposed Willis editorial will be of great help to me.

I can see some of my suggestions gradually going into effect, ~~but~~ it is a slow process, but which I believe will be greatly accelerated in the next few weeks.

I saw Hossack this morning and he asked me to a conference the first part of next week. I am working very closely with Kuehl on matters of policy as he is very receptive.


MEMORANDUM
