

Mr. Smith and I drove to the property which lies on the northern end of the Eagle Tail Mountains on this date. The claims are filed on a yellowish to reddish volcanic dike containing some calcite and quartz and considerable iron. The dike strikes S60° E, dips 52° northerly and is 30 plus feet wide. It appears to cut a rhyolite and is overlain unconformably by a basalt dipping 40° northerly.

Mr. Smith has made a small cut in preparation of driving a drift in on the dike. He reports an initial assay of ¼ oz/ton gold but says that subsequent assays have averaged about 0.1 oz/ton and that the assays appear to be higher near the hanging wall.

He now needs someone with a drill rig and/or money to assist him in further exploration in exchange for an interest in the property.





