

DYNAMITE COPPER DEPOSIT

PIMA COUNTY

2/17/78: The Dynamite copper sulfide deposit is owned by the V.B. Smith Estate and lies, in part, beneath the new conveyor belt that will link the Palo Verde mine to the Twin Buttes mine according to Mr. Addison F. Smith 9025 E. Calle Bolivar, Tucson, Arizona, phone 296-7891. This deposit contains mineralization that has not been drilled sufficiently to determine continuity. sef

NJN WR 11/16/84: The V.B. Smith Estate's (c) Dynamite copper deposit (new) Pima County is referenced in the department's copper report. A general location is given on the V.B. Smith Estate card.

MG WR 10/11/85: The Dynamite copper deposit, located chiefly in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec 30, T17S R13E (Pima County), is owned by the V.B. Smith estate, c/o Mr. Addison Smith, 9025 Calle Bolivar, Tucson Arizona 85715. The deposit has mixed mineralization of oxides and sulfides. According to Mr. A. Smith, there are six drill holes in the property; 100,000,000 tons @0.53% total copper have apparently been identified.

MG WR 2/21/86: Provided general information on the copper industry to Ms. Alice Smith of Tucson, phone 296-0077. She and her brother, Addison Smith are owners of the Dynamite property (Pima County).
