AZ - PROPERTIES LOCATED IN ARIZONA

*Cooke City Prospect.*

The Cooke City Prospect consists of 47 unpatented lode mining claims owned by the Company which cover approximately 940 acres in Park County, Montana.

*Cuprite Hills Prospect.*

The Cuprite Hills Prospect consists of 33 unpatented lode mining claims covering approximately 651 acres located in Esmeralda County, Nevada. These claims are held by EXXON Minerals under an option to purchase which is subject to the Company's right to receive 2½% of the net smelter returns from ore produced from the properties.

↙ *Easter Sunday Prospect.*      C.A.N.D.

The Easter Sunday Prospect consists of nine unpatented lode mining claims owned by the Company which are located in Cochise County, Arizona, and cover approximately 170 acres.

*Elk Prospect.*

The Elk Prospect, which covers approximately 1,418 acres located in Hidalgo County, New Mexico, consists of 54 unpatented lode mining claims owned by the Company and a mining lease held by the Company which reserves to the lessor 5% of the net smelter returns derived from ores produced from the leased property.

*General Thomas Hills Prospect.*

The General Thomas Hills Prospect consists of 123 unpatented lode mining claims owned by RCY Corporation subject to the Company's right to receive 5% of the net smelter returns from production from the property which is located in Esmeralda County, Nevada, and covers approximately 2,460 acres.

*Gold Hill Prospect.*

The Gold Hill Prospect consists of 12 unpatented lode mining claims covering approximately 160 acres in Madison County, Montana, which are owned by the Atlantic Richfield Company and are subject to the Company's 8% net smelter return royalty.

*Home Ranch Prospect.*

The Home Ranch Prospect consists of 69 unpatented lode mining claims in which the Company owns a 40% interest and which cover approximately 1,360 acres located in Luna County, New Mexico. The claims in the prospect are subject to an agreement with the St. Joe American Corporation pursuant to which St. Joe must expend \$150,000 in exploration on or for the benefit of the prospect prior to August 2, 1985, in order to retain its 60% interest. Otherwise, St. Joe's interest will revert to the Company.

*McGinty Ridge Prospect.*

The McGinty Ridge Prospect consists of 18 unpatented lode mining claims owned by the Company covering approximately 360 acres and a Utah State lease held by the Company covering 640 acres. The State lease provides that the State will receive a production royalty equal to 4% of the amount received by lessee, less transportation costs, from the sale of ores produced from the leased properties, to exhaustion.

*Montezuma Peak Prospect.*

The Montezuma Peak Prospect consists of 250 unpatented lode mining claims owned by the Company which cover approximately 5,000 acres located in Esmeralda County, Nevada.

*Mt. Cronin Prospect.*

The Mt. Cronin Prospect is located 16 miles northeast of Smithers, British Columbia. The property is owned by Hallmark Resources, Ltd. Pursuant to an agreement between the Company and Hallmark, the Company has an option to acquire a 60% interest in the property. The property consists of 8 Crown Grants and 27 located claims for a total of approximately 1,600 acres.
