Please feel free to contact us any time we might be of further assistance.

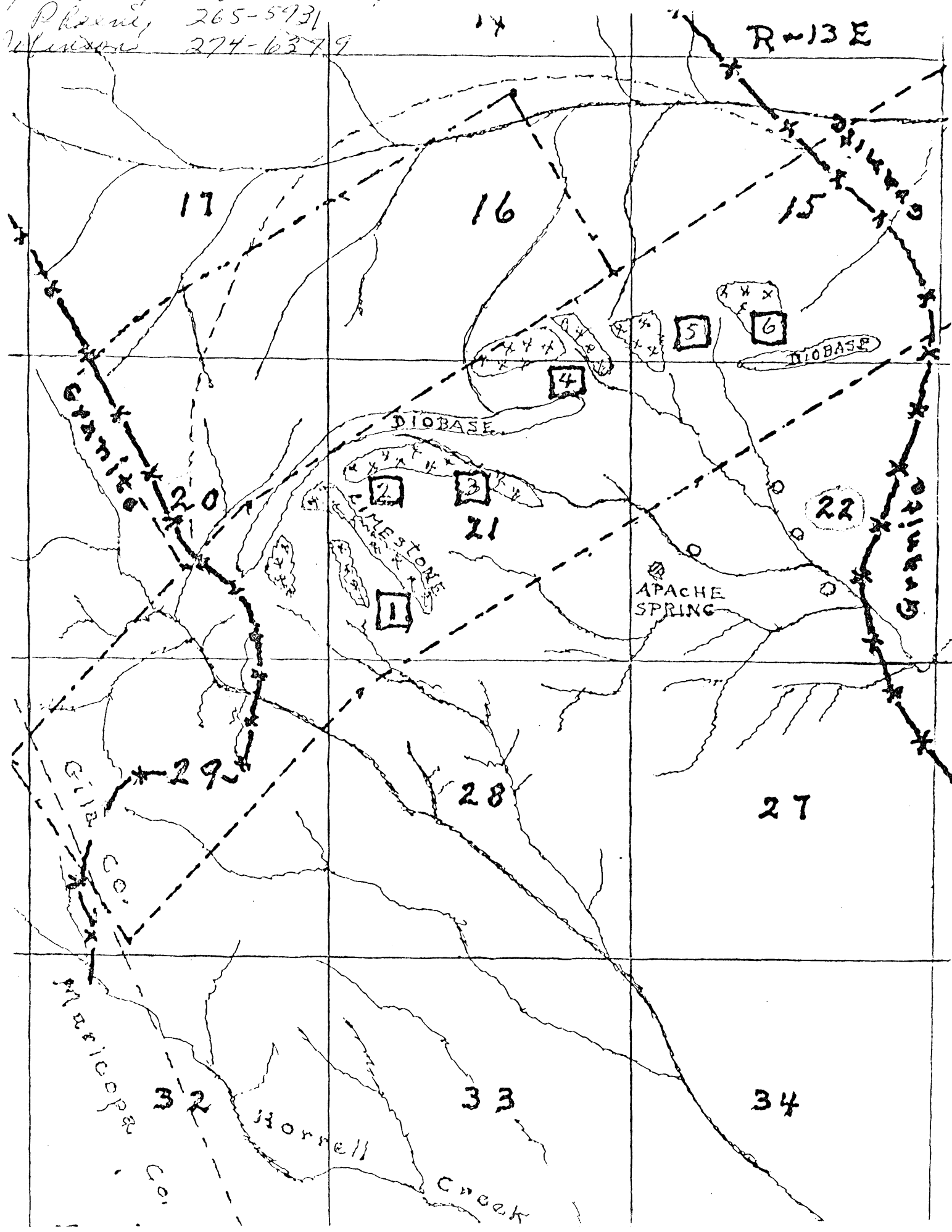

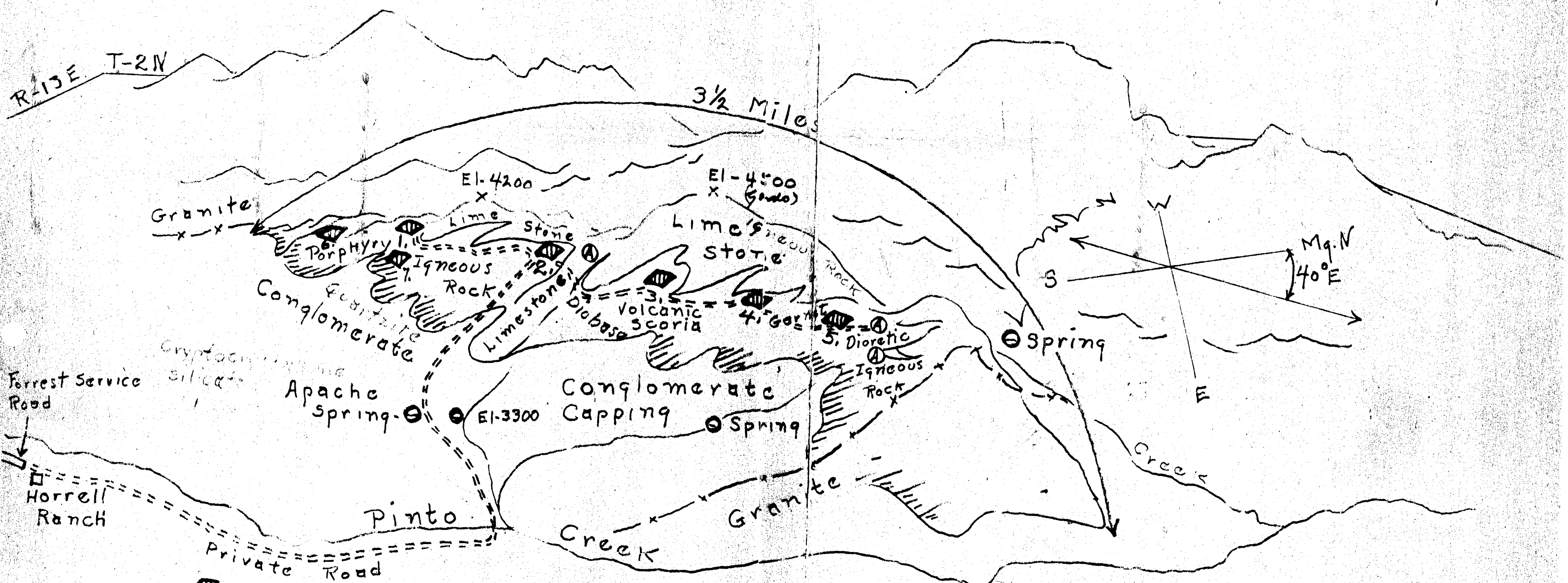
Projected area of El Pito Copper claims
