RRB WR 8/12/83: Don Lindsay, 1960 Atlantic Ave., Kingman, AZ 86401, phone 953-1796, reported that Desert Ranch Inc. of California and Lake Havasu City has a property formerly called the Double Dollar on which they have "blocked out" 500,000 tons at 2.5 oz/ton Au with several million tons possible. It is in the McConico District about 3 miles south of Kingman. They are now setting up a 5,000 ton pad which should be in production in 6 weeks and if it works out they will build a 1,000,000 ton pad. He said the deposit is a series of stringers from the precambrian pegmatite in the area.

KAP WR 11/18/83: Don Lindsay, 421 W. Highway 66, Kingman, Arizona 86401, reported that he thought the Desert Ranch Mining Company, P.O. box 847, Kingman, Arizona 86402, is planning production from the Fourth of July property held by the company. Arizona Eastern Mining Company, McConico District, Mohave County.

NJN WR 11/25/83 Bob Back reported that the Kingman area miners know the Fay Mine as the Double Dollar. The property does contain some one third ounce gold per ton vein material but no 7-10 ounce material as Don Lindsay claims. Mr Lindsay has assembled a small gravity mill on the property.

NJN WR 11/25/83 Bob Back reported that Don Lindsay is operating a company and a mine known as the Fourth of July in Mohave Co. The property consists of the Fourth Of July claims #1, 3-12, 16, owned by Randall Eaton, Box 505, Buena Vista, Colorado 81211. The claims are located in T20N, R17W, Sec. 16 NE 1/4.

NJN WR 3/30/84: Frank Bain with Nicor reported that Nicor has been conducting explorations at the Fay Mine (Arizona Eastern Mining Co. file) Mohave County. Nicor's efforts have mainly been in NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , Sec 29, R17W T20N. Mr. Bain reports Desert Ranch Mining and Milling controls the shafts and prospects in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 28, T20N R17W. There, Desert Ranch is mining mineralized syenite dikes by open pit cuts and trenches. Their mining technique is not the best and so they have lots of dilution with country rock. Desert Ranch hauls the mined material to private land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec 29, T20N R17W where they have set up a heap leaching operation.

NJN WR 12/7/84: W. S. Dubyk, <sup>of Nicor</sup> 2341 S. Friebus #12, Tucson, Arizona 85710 reported that there would soon be a drilling operation at the Fay Mine, Mohave County.

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NJN WR 1/4/85: Don Lindsay (c) reported that Desert Ranch Mining and Milling recovered about 50 oz Au from their heap leach operation. The recovery was from small adularia veins that carried the mineralization at the Arizona Eastern Mining Co. (f) Mohave County.

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NJN WR 4/19/85: At Desert Ranch Mining and Milling's millsite (Az Eastern Mining Co) (f) Mohave County an operator reported the operation has been taken over by a new owner, Dixie Mining. The millsite was originally put on BLM land not on private land as planned. Dixie's plans are to restore the site to appease the BLM and move their operation to California.

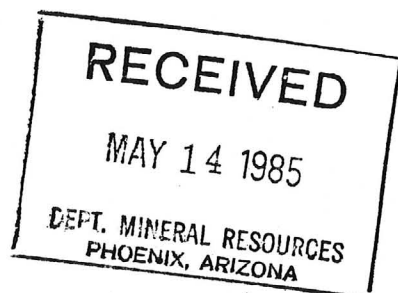

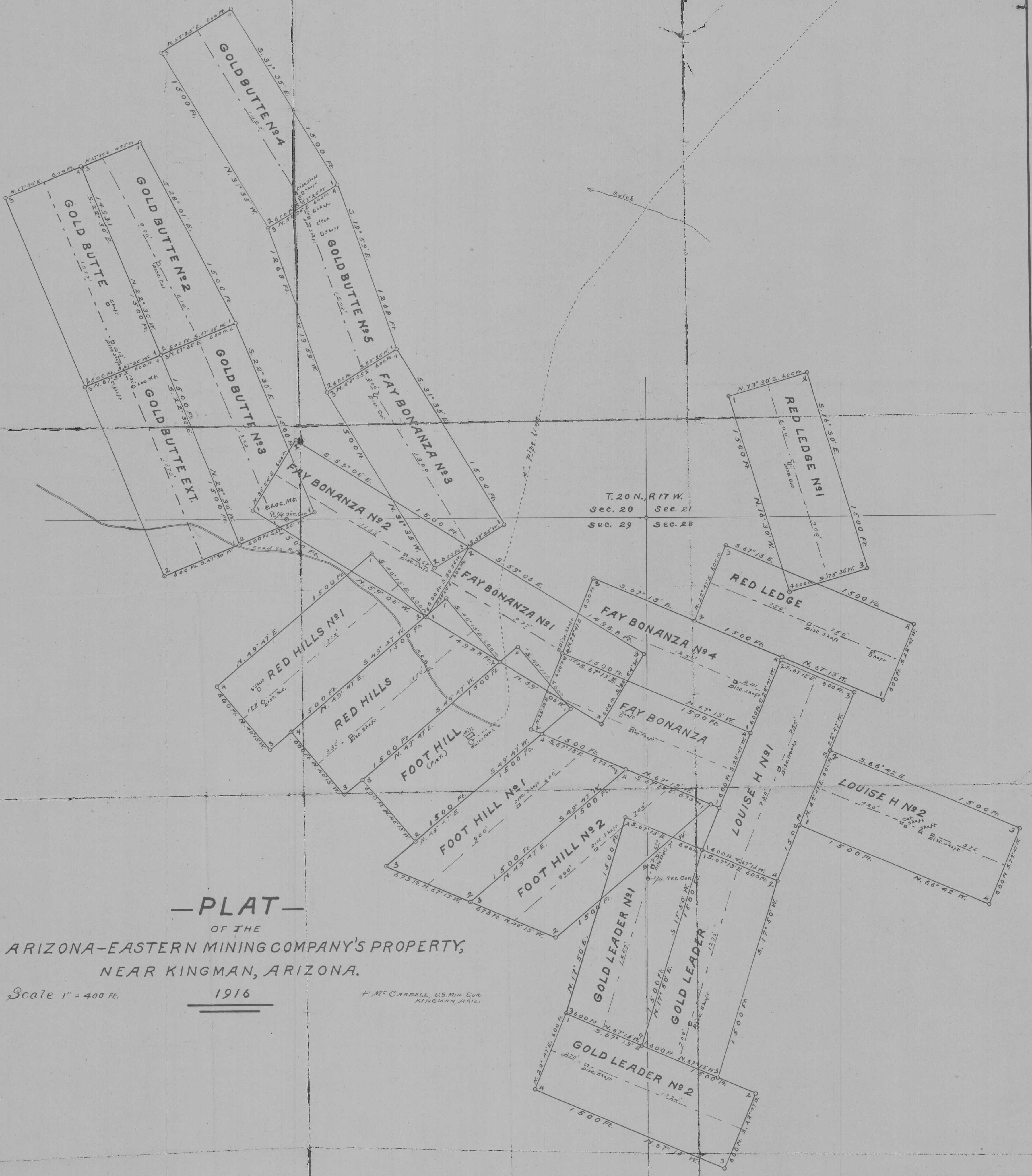
