

MG WR 8/16/85: Visited the First Chance mine (Cochise County). The southeastern end of the "bid ledge", a prominent, thick quartz vein, outcrops in this area. The First Chance workings are slightly north of the quartz ledge, however, and in a geologic environment similar to the nearby Gold Prince mine. Phelps Dodge has built a very steep road on the south side of the ridge where the east workings are located.

MG WR 2/7/87: Mr. Terry Antoniuk (c) of Toronto was in to review the Gold Prince (file) Cochise County. He reports that his company (Rayrock Yellow-knife Resources Inc.) has been asked by Queenstake Resources to participate in the exploration and development of the Gold Prince mine. (The property package apparently also includes the First chance, Gold Ridge and Dives areas; all in files of Cochise County.) Mr. Antoniuk expressed the hope that enough tonnage could be developed to supply a 200 to 400 tpd mill on the proerty.
