

GEOLOGY

Conglomerate-Diorite (gray) contact on Franklin Nos. 1, 2, and 3. Vien strikes N 35 E Dips N. W. 55° and is in evidence at different points for a lateral distance of 3800 feet.

On the Franklin Extension a vein in andesite is in evidence for 362 feet along the strike and varies from a few inches to several feet in width. It was the finding of this vein by tracing rich gold ore float that led to the location of the claims, pending a more thorough investigation. The following is a list of assays from the various exposures.
