✓ The Fruitpeddler Prospect consists of 15 claims bordering the patented Pruitt Claims 11 mi. South of Prescott, east of U.S. 89. The owner is Robert Lucas, 5 E. Benton, Flagstaff, Ariz.

✓ Previous owner and original locator was Nathan Johnstone of Prescott.

The vein is a shear zone in granite porphory dike, Strike NW, Dip 55°SE, and appears to be 4 - 6 feet wide. Country rock is granite gneiss and schist. Mineralization is disseminated through the granite porphory and has values in copper and lead but is mostly pyrites. High grade assays as much as \$20 Au and 6 oz. Hg. according to Mr. Lucas. The surface ore is a high limonite gossion typical of gold ores derived from pyrite.

A shallow shaft, some short drifts and bulldozer cuts are all the work that has been done.
