

Dear Concerned Citizen:

NE The Bradshaw Ranger District has received a plan of operations from FTC Metals, Inc. of Phoenix, Arizona for mining approximately 6 air miles southwest of Humboldt, Arizona. The legal description of the project is Section 24, Township 12 1/2 North, Range 1 West, G&SRBM. The area is shown on the attached map.

The proposal calls for mining along a projected vein using a tracked excavator. The depth of the trench would be approximately 30 feet deep and vary in width from 110 feet at the surface to 50 feet wide at the bottom. No processing would be done on site; all ore would be hauled to a private facility for milling. A copy of the plan of operations is available for review at this office.


FTC Metals has proposed stockpiling overburden adjacent to the pit and backfilling/reclaiming concurrently and exposure of the vein progresses. Reclamation proposed includes backfilling, recontouring and revegetating all disturbed areas. The project area contains extensive disturbance from past operations. Much of the proposal involves previously disturbed areas. The area has had considerable sampling and mineral exploration done through previous operations.

Initial concerns identified with this project include:

- possible affects on a Mexican spotted owl previously sighted two miles to the west
- affects on water quality
- loss of vegetation (the vegetation is chaparral, no riparian areas are involved)
- public safety

We are conducting an environmental analysis of the proposal. We would appreciate your input into the analysis, if you have concerns specific to this proposal. Please provide your comments in writing to this office by November 29, 1991.
