Gentlemen:

The writer wishes to submit to you, facts regarding a prospect which he is now operating, and breaking ore. It may be possible you might have parties who would be interested in this property. I would be glad to pay a good commission to you for placing same in the hands of some one.

The property consists of 6 claims. Two claims length covers the vein on which we are now working. The vein shows the entire length of the two claims. I am at present breaking ore fifteen feet from the surface.

in a shaft 80 foot depth, the same showing ore from top to bottom and at present has 30 feet of water. The vein is a true fissure and is about 6 ft. of mineralized rock having quartz veins varying in width from 8 inches to three feet in width. The ore contains 3 to 9 % zinc, 2 to 5 % lead, 1.5 to 3 oz silver and .95 oz gold. This makes an ideal ore for a small milling operation, say twenty five tons. There is no doubt about the property being a permanent producer if equipped with the proper facilities for reduction of its ore. The property is free from any debt, has a complete outfit regarding hand mining equipment. Two small houses. Any kind of a fair deal will be given on the property. We are not looking for any cash payments, unless anyone would want to buy. The shaft doesn't make water. Sufficient water can be had for milling operations by tapping a source some 2000 ft

distance from the main workings. The roads are good, except for a few feet and we join the Dugones property which the Calahouns had since have leased from the Bracy Cuptice estate and are now operating. The New Trench Mill is just 10 miles distant. They have under consideration the milling of the ore. The sticker being what to do about the high gold content. They seem to think the gold would lodge along the different launders carrying the concentrate, causing a considerable loss as they have no gold content in their ores. I base my qualifications in submitting this property to you on my many years active mining and milling. Should you send anyone, it would be appreciated if you would give advance notice of arrival, so we would be sure of seeing you at the proper time.
