Both of these samples came from Godfather III. I know sample # 1 came from Godfather II further on top of the hill, remember Dick found that vein.

Ann and I took a sample that I chipped out myself from Godfather III vein to Statler at the Iron King on June 12th. I received the report this morning ie; AU .084 ---AG .12 which doesn't sound too shaggy a what ?



Dear Mr. Lasky:

Enclosed please find the results of samples taken during our examination of your Godfather claims. It appears that the gold is restricted to the quartz lenses. This being the case, the property is not of interest to Inspiration because of the low volume of material available. The copper and zinc assays are about average background values for the type of rock in your area.

Thank you for inviting me up. Hope to see you again sometime. I have also enclosed some material pertaining to amalgamating gold and a paper describing volcanogenic massive sulphide deposits. The gold mineralization on your claims is probably related to this type of mineral occurrence.

Dear Mr. Lasky:

Thank you for sending the six samples. They arrived in this morning's mail.

Our senior geologist, Mr. Gary Schrock, examined each sample under the microscope and had the following comments:

Sample #1: It is a metavolcanic rock. Nothing unusual, but common rock forming minerals which are relatively fresh.

Sample #2: A chloritized metavolcanic rock. No obvious mineralization. It has minor quartz lenses with drusy cavities.

Sample #3: A metavolcanic rock. Fresh looking amphibolite schist that is fine grained. No obvious mineralization but some white clay spots.

Sample #4: A chloritized metavolcanic rock with very small bedding lenses of limonite after pyrite.

Au .0502 Ag .02502 Cu .14% Zn .029% Sb .02902


Sample #5: A chloritized metavolcanic rock with minor specular hematite pseudomorphs after pyrite. Pink stained quartz veinlets (iron stained) not uncommon.

Sample #6: Quartz and calcite veinlets. Traces of pyrite, possibly some stibnite which may be the shiny, metallic gray, splintery mineral. All of these in a chloritized metavolcanic rock.

Au .16602 Ag .1302 Cu .011% Zn .045% Sb .011%

To be sure we haven't overlooked anything, we have sent two of the samples to our lab for assay. We'll advise of those results after they are available.


