I have today asked the ASMOA to send you the information regarding meeting dates of the Phoenix Council, and you will no doubt hear from them within a short time.

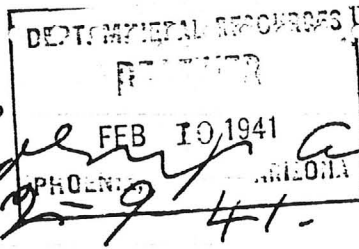
I should suggest that you go to the Phoenix Blue Print Company, Home Builders Building, for a township map. I do not know the price, but you can get the information from them.

Dear Sir.

I am a new member of the A.S.M.O.A.
and I see in the Pay dirt that we are
invited to register with your dept any
owning Property that we have for sale or
lease. So am sending this description
of what we have. The Placer Claims
recorded as the Golden Bar & Golden
Bar Extension. Consisting of 16 Claims
located at the junction of Humburg Creek
and the Agua Fria river at the extreme
upper end of Carl Pleasant Lake. I have
good maps and other descriptions of
this Property it is in Township 7 N. 10 E.
Range 1 E. We have about three million
yds of gravel there & I believe it will
average 50 cts per yd. However I have a
copy of a statement made by Prof. R.J.
Jeanard of the University of Ariz in
1934 which states that his tests
shows a higher value per yd.
now we did not try to sell this Property
until the new road was put through
from the dam to Castle Hot Springs
and the road was shortened from

90 mi. vanorris tour. to 4. mi. via the
lake. now. we have contacted a group
of ml in Minneapolis Minn. & they
are here now & just making camp &
starting to build a small sampling
machine to test the values with &
if you can give them any information
as to the kind of machine best ad-
apted to recover all the values possible
I am sure if they can recover as
much as 35 or 50 cts per yd in their
sampling. they will buy the property
and have agreed to put in a machine
that will handle at least 500 yds per
day. they say if it samples OK. they
will pay \$1000 one thousand dollars down
when they through sampling. and when
they move a machine on the property
and pay 15% of the gross recovered
and guaranteed it to be not less than
\$500 per mt. until purchase price is
paid out. so I am thanking you in
advance for any help your Dept can
give us. right a way. respt
