



KAP WR 2/13/87: Harold Voris, P O Box 416, Quartzsite, Arizona 85346 was in for help in laying out a group of lode claims to protect his Golden Crest placer claims (file) in Sec 35, T4N R20W, La Paz County. He reports to have recovered some placer gold using a dry washer on a somewhat hobby basis. Assisted him by drawing a claim group map of the section. He has located the Lucky Mae group of 36 claims on the property. Further, he reported that Sprint Communications had knocked down and buried some of his claim monuments during the construction of an underground communications cable. He met with a field representative from Sprint and will receive compensation for the cost of re-establishing the monuments.

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KAP WR 4/10/87: Rene Von Beck, Inspiration Gold, Miami, Arizona, phone 473-7164 (new name and possibly new phone number for Inspiration Development Company) called regarding Harold Voris' Golden Crest (file), La Paz County. The property had been submitted to Inspiration. The only information we have is verbal from Mr. Voris as to his recovery of gold using hobby dry placer equipment.

Harold Voris reported he and his "association of placer miners" located four association placer claims covering all of Section 35, T4N R20W, in February, 1981. He explained they have routinely operated hobby type dry washers on the property during the winters.

He feels his hobby operations have shown sufficient placer gold recovery to justify submitting the property to a company for exploration. He does not have any detailed data.

Mr. Voris explained a problem with over staking. His Golden Crest placer claims were located in February, 1981. A group of lode claims known as Lizard Lips Group was staked on the same ground by Norman Dausinger in February, 1985. Mr. Voris felt the Lizard Lips claims were not properly staked and located his own group of lode claims over his placer claims. His lode claims are the Lucky Mae 1-36.
