KAP WR 2/17/84: Steve Pylant, P.O. Box 893, Mayer, Arizona Ph 632-9201 reported he has located three claims, the Mystic #1 & #2 (AMC #201348 & 201349) and the Sunset #2 (AMC #201918) on an old property known as the Golden Crown Mine, Cherry Creek District, Yavapai County. He explained that the vein contains quartz, iron staining, and chalcopryrite. He has taken two (probably select) samples which ran 0.9 tr. oz. Au/ton and 1.2 tr. oz Au/ton. Also, there is an inclined drift on the property. Production data from the Bureau of Geology and Mineral Technology was obtained for the file. Mr. Pylant pans further prospecting at the property. The claims are located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$. Sec. 12, T13N, R2E. The property also corresponds to Yavapai MILS 659.
