Osborne said that C. P. Dennis is the owner and that the claims (7 originally) are next to the Coronation. LAS Memo 10-14-65

Mr. Irv Schoenberg, 3361 Bagley Avenue, Los Angeles, California, reported he had obtained an option on 22 claims comprising the Golden Ray Mines, about ten miles northeast of Parker and reached by a road going eastward from Cienega Springs on the Colorado River.

He said the property had been studied and reported on by Mr. Harvey Smith of Scottsdale. He said he would send us a copy of this report. Thirty holes averaging 100' deep have been drilled showing hematite under which is chrysocolla and malachite. He says he already has an outlet for the iron with a Japanese firm which will also put up the money for developing the whole property. He is planning a 400 to 500 ton leaching operation for the oxidized copper. He reports that there is also commercial marble on the property. Mr. Louie Hohn is the caretaker living at the site.

Mr. Schoenberg says he is at present operating 36 claims in Nevada and has a 40 day option on the Copper Tex Mercury mine in San Bernadino County, California near the Golden Eagle 11½ miles from Vidal Junction. He claims the property also has copper, silver, and titanium. Parker Conference CLH 2-15-68

Mr. Irv Schoenberg of Los Angeles, California has taken an option on the Golden Ray group of claims about 10 miles northeast of Parker. He is planning to mine copper ore for leaching and iron ore for sale to a Japanese firm. CLH WR 2-17-68
