KAP WR 3/14/86: John Hankins (c) reported that a small prospect on the west side of the Vulture Mine – Wickenburg was actually the Bar FX vermiculite discovery shaft, but I doubt it as the diggings appear to be a discovery (or location work) pit in a narrow (1-3 inch) quartz vein containing oxide copper minerals. The vein is exposed in both walls of the pit. It strikes E-W and dips 50 ° to the east. The occurrence is located in the NW, Sec 21, T7N R5W and is a new MILS occurrence.
