

- 9. Type of Surrounding Terrain: Very rough and rocky.
- 10. Geology and Mineralization: Surrounded with volcanic mountains. The limestone dyke seems to have tilted and been pushed up.



- 11. Dimension and Value of Ore Body: Roughly the two claims have at least 10,000,000 tons of lime. This is a very conservative estimate.

12. Ore "Blocked Out" or "In Sight": There are two large hills, some 500 ft high of solid limestone and marble. It is not suitable for building material as it is too badly broken up.
