SUMMARY

A brief discussion was held with Carol Kinder-Stevens, Secretary/Treasurer, Kinder and Sons Agricultural Gypsum, P.O. Box 45, Wilcox, Arizona 85644, phone (520) 384-4489. Her and her father's company have been mining, selling, and spreading gypsum on farm fields in Cochise and Graham Counties for over 30 years. She reports to have over 50 regular customers and her gypsum has a fertilizer license number from the Arizona Department of Agriculture's State Chemist. Their gypsum mine is northeast of D Hill east of Douglas. There they mine gypsum from a local gypsiferous bed in Quaternary alluvium. The mine run rock is crushed, screened and loaded into spreader trucks for delivery and application to agricultural fields. Information on the property is included in the Cochise County Gypsite Quarry mine file; AZMILS 108. Attempts have been made to contact Kinder and Sons Agricultural Gypsum for inclusion in our Directory of Active Mine for the last three years without success. They will be included in the 1999 directory.


