NJN WR 1/24/86: Hal Perry reported that he has been sampling the old smelter slag tailings at the Remert site shown on the Mineral Mountain 7.5 quadrangle. This site is located at T2S R11E Sec 27C and is apparently the same location as Pinal Co. MILS 186A - Habstritts Silver Lode. The samples of slag there contain a trace of gold and 6-7 oz of silver per ton.

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NJN WR 4/24/87: Robert Johnson (card) reported that he has bought the patented claim that contains the slag at the Reymont site, Pinal County. He has been analyzing it for its gold and silver and having recovery test done. He is seeking a custom mill to process it. (Habstritts - file)

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NJN WR 1/15/88: Hal Perry (card) reported he has leased from Bob Johnson, the Habstritts (file) Pinal County. He plans to take a pilot lot of the slag to Archie Stutenroth for gravity concentration.
