LOCATION: Six miles SW of Payson on very rough road.

OWNERSHIP: Owner is Walter[✓] Holder, Payson, Arizona.

GEOLOGY & ORE BODY: Country rock is granite. Veins are in parallel fault zones and related fractures in granite. One vein about 18" wide is said to have produced one ton of \$500 ore.

One vein is about 4' wide, sample pans a very small amount of gold.[✓]
Strike of vein - SW-NE, dip 40° NW.

WORK DONE: An X-cut 100' long running SE intersects two parallel veins - on first 18" vein a drift extends a few feet each way. On second 4' vein drift extends 50' SW and 150' NE.
